Journey to Konstanz

- Closest airport: Zurich, Stuttgart, Basel, Karlsruhe, Memmingen, Friedrichshafen
- Train station: Constance

Parking in Konstanz

- Fenced parking lot near the Radweg-Reisen office in Constance, must be booked and paid in advance.
- Parking garages (Fischmarkt, Dammgasse, Lago, Altstadt, Benediktinerplatz), costs approx. 25 Euro / day
- Hotel parking spaces (available in individual hotels, chargeable, details in the travel documents)

Bike handover

- Pick-up at Radweg-Reisen in Konstanz between 9 am and 7 pm, 7 days per week. On request delivery to the hotel, then no individual adjustment by our staff on site. Departure: Return at Radweg-Reisen or guests leave them at the hotel.

Luggage transport

- Luggage pick-up from 09.00 a.m., delivery to the next hotel by 06.00 p.m. at the latest, labeling of luggage is 1 x for the whole tour. No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but max. 20 kg per piece of luggage.

Travel documents

- 1 set (per booked room) consists of: hotel list and voucher, travel information with details on daily stages, short travel guides and route descriptions, maps, luggage tags
- Dispatched up to four weeks before arrival. For short-term bookings, delivery to the start hotel, hotel list and arrival information will be sent by email

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Constance

Take the opportunity to visit the island of Mainau, wander through Constance's old town or visit the aquariums in the Sea Life Center and go to the Archaeological Museum.

Day 2: Konstanz – Gailingen / Wangen, approx. 30 – 40 km (Cat A), Constance – Gailingen / Stein am Rhein, approx. 30 – 50 km (Cat B), Constance – Wangen / Hemmenhofen, approx. 35 km (Cat K)

The first stage of your cycle tour takes you along the Swiss shore of Untersee to Stein am Rhein. The town has one of the most beautiful medieval town centres on Lake Constance and impresses with its colourfully painted facades. A few kilometres downstream you will reach Gailingen, Stein am Rhein or cycle to the picturesque Hõri peninsula to Wangen or Hemmenhofen. The painter Otto Dix once lived in Hemmenhofen and the writer Hermann Hesse in Gaienhofen.

Day 3: Gailingen – Überlingen, approx. 45 / 60 km (Cat A), Gailingen – Ludwigshafen / Überlingen, approx. 40 – 60 km (Cat B), Wangen – Überlingen, approx. 45 km (Cat K)

Today you will circle the Hõri peninsula and reach the spa town of Radolfzell. Visit the Radolfzell Minster, which has the highest church tower on Lake Constance. Over the Bodanrück (beware, hilly!) you will pass Bodman-Ludwigshafen and Sipplingen. Following the cycle path along the shore of Lake Überlingen, you will reach the town of the same name, Überlingen. From a distance you can already see the stately St. Nikolaus Minster. Stroll along the approximately five-kilometer-long lakeside promenade and enjoy the view of the lake and its maritime flair.

Day 4: Überlingen – Lindau / Kressbronn, approx. 60 / 45 km (Cat A), Ludwigshafen – Kressbronn / Lindau, approx. 50 – 60 km (Cat B), Überlingen – Lindau, approx. 60 km (Cat K)

Your journey today takes you along the Obersee. First, make a stop at the pilgrimage church of Birnau. Situated amidst vineyards, the forecourt of the splendidly decorated baroque church offers a wonderful view over the lake. Visit the pile-dwelling museum in Unteruhldingen, Germany's oldest inhabited castle in Meersburg, and be impressed by the largest collection on the history of aviation in Friedrichshafen. The old town of Lindau is located on an island. Enjoy the view of the Alps at the harbor - in the foreground the town's landmarks: the Bavarian Lion and the 33-meter-high lighthouse.

Day 5: Lindau – Arbon, approx. 50 km (Cat A), Kressbronn – Höchst / Rorschach, approx. 55 – 65 km (Cat B), Lindau – Horn, approx. 45 km (Cat K)

Continuing on your way, you reach Bregenz, the capital of the Vorarlberg region of Austria and famous for its annual festival on the largest lake-stage in the world. You finally reach Höchst where you soon cross the border again and then, after pedaling onwards for a few kilometres, reach Rorschach or Arbon.

Day 6: Arbon – Constance, approx. 30 km (Cat A), Höchst – Constance, approx. 40 – 65 km (Cat B), Horn – Constance, approx. 35 km (Cat K)

Your tour today takes you through Romanshorn with the largest Lake Constance port in Switzerland. The tour continues along Lake Constance back to Constance. End the day with a stroll through the old town or an ice cream at the harbour.

Day 7: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
