
Main Cycle Path – Part 1

Cycle from the beer town of Kulmbach at the confluence of the Red and White Main to the thousand-year-old city of Bamberg and finally experience the lively wine Franconian metropolis of Würzburg. And resting here also has special qualities: With wine and beer and the delicious specialities of the region.

Child reduction on basic price

Parking in Kulmbach

- → Closest airports: Nuremberg, Frankfurt am Main
- → Train station: Kulmbach

Bike handover

- \rightarrow Arrival: The rental bikes are waiting at the start hotel.
- → Departure: The guests leave their bikes in the last hotel. Provided an e-bike has been rented, the battery should be handed in at reception.

Luggage transport

- → Daily baggage collection until 9 a.m.
- → Delivery to the next hotel by 6 p.m. at the latest
- → Luggage items are labeled once for the entire tour
- → No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but a maximum of 20 kg per piece of luggage

Return journey to Kulmbach

→ On your own by train, connections several times every day, duration approx. 2 – 3 hours, 1 – 2 train changes.

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Kulmbach

The brewery and old margrave town of Kulmbach invites you in for a wander to see its old walls, towers and rambling little lanes. If you like a more athletic approach: a lovely route takes you up to Plassenburg Castle - the town's striking landmark. The views up here are wonderful.

Day 2: Trip to Bayreuth, approx. 60 km

Today you're going on a trip to the world-famous festival town of Bayreuth, where many musical, architectural and landscaped sights await you. This, Upper Franconia's largest town, is home to many historic buildings and museums.

Day 3: Kulmbach – Bad Staffelstein, approx. 45 km

Just after you leave Kulmbach is where the Red and the White Main rivers meet. The young Main makes its way into an ever widening valley. In between the Franconian Forest and the Franconian Jura, you cycle along quiet forest paths and field trails. At today's destination, the Obermain Thermal baths await you!

Day 4: Bad Staffelstein – Bamberg, approx. 35 km

Enjoy the colourful meadows and old orchards of the flat and expansive Main Valley, its small villages and the treats they have in store. The historic quarter of Bamberg, declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site, is the rousing highlight of today's Main cycle path section: the town is home to nine breweries!

Day 5: Bamberg – Schweinfurt, approx. 60 km

You will be cycling through the valley, following the Main. Today's stage will leisurly take you through wine villages and orchards along the river. Later, you will cycle through Haßfurt and finally reach Schhweinfurt in Lower Franconia, with its beautiful Holy Trinity church.

Day 6: Schweinfurt – Kitzingen, approx. 60 km

In the pilgrimage church Maria im Weingarten, which was built in the 15th century, you will find the famous floating Madonna in the Rosary by Riemenschneider. Volkach is the centre of the Maindreieck wine region.The Main continues meandering along the valley towards Kitzingen, which is famous as it boasts the oldest wine cellar in Germany.

Day 7: Kitzingen – Würzburg, approx. 35 km

They usually drive directly along the Main towards the "sugar town" Ochsenfurt and then roll steadily along the right bank of the river, accompanied by barrages, marinas and vineyards. Again and again you will pass charming little villages before finally reaching the pulsating city of Würzburg. This lively baroque and cultural city is surrounded by vineyards and dominated by the Marienberg Fortress.

Day 8: Individual departure or extension of stay

After breakfast, you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
