# Round trip on the Main from Würzburg

#### Your tour

The journey begins in time-honoured Würzburg. The residential town impresses with its remarkable cityscape and puts you in the mood for a relaxed cycle tour. On the Main, lined by vineyards and forests, the cycle path takes you almost without any ascents to the "Snow White Town" of Lohr and Wertheim, known for its castle ruins visible from afar. You return to Würzburg on the Aalbach cycle path. The penultimate stage takes you to the Volkacher Mainschleife, the heart of Franconian winegrowing. The destination of the tour is Würzburg.

- → Closest airports: Frankfurt am Main, Munich, Stuttgart

#### Parking in Würzburg

- → Market garage on the market square, 520 parking spaces, unlimited time, costs approx. 11 euros / day.
- → Talavera car park, Mainaustraße, 1000 parking spaces, unlimited, free of charge.
- → Hotel parking spaces (available in individual hotels, chargeable, details in the travel documents).

#### Bike handover

- → Arrival: The rental bikes are waiting at the start hotel.
- → Departure: The bikes are left at the last hotel. Provided an e-bike has been rented, the battery should be handed in at reception.

#### Luggage transport

- → Daily baggage collection until 9 a.m.
- → Delivery to the next hotel by 6 p.m. at the latest
- → Luggage items are labeled once for the entire tour
- → No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but a maximum of 20 kg per piece of luggage

#### **Travel documents**

- → Dispatched to the tour operator up to six weeks before arrival
- → For short-term bookings, delivery to the start hotel, hotel list and arrival information will be sent by email
- → 1 set (per booked room) consists of: hotel list and voucher, travel information with details on daily stages, short travel guides and route descriptions, maps, luggage tags

#### **Stages description**

#### Day 1: Individual arrival in Würzburg

Welcome to the residential city of Würzburg. After your arrival, you should start right away with a walk through the city, because there is a lot to see here. The Marienberg Fortress, the Würzburg Residence and the Old Main Bridge are not to be missed. Churches, monasteries and glamorous secular buildings can be found on almost every corner. The atmosphere in the old town is very pleasant and relaxed due to the many students. Numerous cafés and wine bars are waiting to get to know you.

#### Day 2: Würzburg - Gemünden / Lohr, approx. 45 / 60 km

You start from Würzburg in a north-westerly direction. The first stop is not long on the way. In Veitshöchheim you can visit the former summer residence of the Würzburg prince bishops including the rococo garden. Continue along the Main to the three-river town of Gemünden. The element of water is omnipresent in the town. How about a canoe tour? Climb the Scherenburg, from where you have a beautiful view over the Main valley! Not far from Gemünden is the charming half-timbered town of Lohr. Strolling through the historic fishermen's quarter and the lively pedestrian zone, you won't get bored. You stay overnight in Gemünden or in Lohr.

## Day 3: Gemünden / Lohr – Marktheidenfeld / Wertheim, approx. 60 / 45 km

You drive through the Spessart-Mainland. Lush vineyards accompany you. Take a break in Marktheidenfeld on this longer stage. You are sure to enjoy the town with its historic half-timbered houses, cosy cafés and small shops. The baroque Franck House is Marktheidenfeld's landmark along with the St. Laurentius Church. If you stay overnight in Wertheim, you will pass the ruins of Wertheim Castle on your way there. Don't be afraid to make the climb! You will be offered a beautiful view over the Main. Wertheim is guaranteed to enchant you with its romantic character.

#### Day 4: Marktheidenfeld / Wertheim - Würzburg, approx. 45 km

This stage first takes you away from the Main from Bettingen. You follow the Aalbach cycle path in a westerly direction. Cycling through the Aalbach valley is very varied. You have to reckon with some uphill stretches. You should not miss the former Benedictine monastery in Holzkirchen. After arriving in Würzburg, you have the opportunity to visit the Käppele, a pilgrimage church, via a station trail with 14 chapels. But the Botanical Garden and St. Kilian's Cathedral are also worth a visit.

#### Day 5: Würzburg – Volkach / Sommerach, approx. 30 / 35 km

From Würzburg you follow the 2-Franken-Radweg today. On the way, there are always wonderful views over the Main valley and the vineyards. You cycle along extensive vegetable and grain fields to the wine town of Volkach. Attractions include the market square with the historic town hall, the Schelfenhaus and the pilgrimage church Maria im Weingarten. Take advantage of the opportunity and go on an adventure hike in a vineyard. You will spend the night in Volkach or Sommerach.

### Day 6: Volkach / Sommerach – Ochsenfurt – Würzburg, approx. 60 / 55 km

Today you cycle along the Main to the historic wine trading town of Kitzingen. A walk through the winding alleys provides information about the town's diverse history. Colourful half-timbered houses and the Old Main Bridge characterise the townscape. Visit the town's landmark, the Falter Tower. The tour continues to the southern tip of the Main triangle. In Ochsenfurt, visit the historic old town with its almost complete fortifications. The only beer town in Franconia's wine country has two breweries. A swim on the Main Island is tempting before you make your way to Würzburg.

#### Day 7: Individual departure or extension of stay

After breakfast, you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.

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
