

Experience a fascinating cycle tour through Lower Silesia! This eight-day round trip takes you from the vibrant city of Wroclaw to the idyllic nature of the Barycza Landscape Park. Historic monasteries, picturesque villages and impressive castles line your route. Highlights include a city tour of Wrocław, a visit to the Hatzfeld palace ruins in Żmigród and a wine tasting in the St. Anna winery. The route is easy to complete and is ideal for leisure cyclists. Discover the perfect combination of nature, culture and culinary experiences on your bike!

Itinerary

Luggage transport

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Wrocław / Breslau

At 5:30 p.m., meet with the Polish tour guide at the starting hotel in Wroclaw. After that, there will be a city tour with such sights as the market square with the Gothic town hall, the Elisabethenkirche and on through the university quarter, the 4 temples district, where an Orthodox cathedral, the synagogue 'Under the White Stork', a Catholic church and a Protestant church are located at intervals of just under 300 metres. A lively centre of encounter and dialogue has been created here. Afterwards, dinner at a cosy restaurant in Wroclaw.

Day 2: Breslau / Wrocław - Trebnitz /Trzebnica, approx. 45 km

The bikes are handed out after breakfast. The first few kilometres take us along the Oder through Wrocław's city centre. Next, we leave the city on cycle paths through the most beautiful nature reserves on the Oder, green areas and picturesque landscapes between the Oder and Widawa rivers.

In the afternoon, we cycle northwards through fields, blossoming orchards, forests and small villages to the small town of Trzebnica/ Trebnitz. A coffee and cake break in Trzebnica at St Hedwig's Monastery, followed by a tour of St Hedwig's Monastery. The church in Trzebnica is the oldest sanctuary in Lower Silesia.

Day 3: Trebnitz – Barycza Landscape park – Pakosław, approx. 50 km + transfer

After breakfast, a short transfer to Prusice, where we enter the cycling paradise. Cycle along beautiful routes to Żmigród and visit the palace ruins of the Hatzfeld family. In the afternoon, our cycle tour takes us through the most beautiful corners of the Barycz Valley. A paradise for nature lovers. Next up is the Barycza Landscape Park. We see more and more ponds and alder forests.

Day 4: Pakosław - Rawicz - Bienenland - Pakosław, approx. 45 km

After breakfast, cycle through small villages to the town of Rawicz. The town fascinates with its unique atmosphere, but also its exciting history and sights. Then cycle to the palace of the Czarnecki family in Golejewko. There is a one-hour tour of the stud farm. Relax at Lake Pakosław in the afternoon. After dinner, visit to the lively honey museum. The beekeeper introduces us to honey production and the life of bees.

Day 5: Pakosław – Barycz River – Milicz – Ruda Sułowska, approx. 30 km + transfer

After breakfast, a short bus transfer in the direction of Milicz. In Nowe Grodzisko we get on our bikes and cycle to the centre of "bike country" to the village of Milicz. We then visit the half-timbered church and the glass hall museum

In the afternoon, we cycle along cycle paths to the heart of the Barycz Valley - the village of Ruda Sułowska. On the way, we cycle through

areas reminiscent of 19th century Lower Silesia. On the way, we stop at the palaces of the Salisch and von Burghaus families. We cycle to our hotel on beautiful paths between the ponds. After we have checked into our rooms, a delicious dinner awaits us in the local fish restaurant with local specialities.

Day 6: Excursion to the Barycza Landscape Park, approx. 30 km

Cycle tour in the western part of the landscape park, between Milicz and Zmigród. Through picturesque and mysterious corners surrounded by ponds and forests. We cycle on a comfortable circular route – the beginning and end of the cycle tour start at the same point in Ruda Sułowska. This tour is suitable for every nature-loving cyclist who loves remote places and stunning views. Free time in the afternoon. For those interested, there is also the possibility of fishing.

Day 7: Ruda Sułowska – Milicz – Breslau, approx. 35 km + transfers

After breakfast, short bus transfer to Milicz. Today's cycle stage leads along the disused railway embankment of a narrow-gauge railway. One of the most interesting cycling stages in this region amidst picturesque fields, forests and the Milicz Ponds water complex. A bird paradise awaits us here - its biggest inhabitant is the stork! With a bit of luck, we might even spot a white-tailed eagle. The last section of today's cycling stage runs across the scenically unique Krosnicki Ponds. We end the cycle tour with a glass of wine tasting in the St Anne's winery. Afterwards bus transfer to Wroclaw. On the way, a stopover at the palace of the von Reichenbach family in Goszcz.

Day 8: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
