Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival to Stockholm

After your arrival in Stockholm, take some time for a first tour of the town. The town hall with its striking corner tower is an example of Swedish national romanticism. Of particular significance is the parallel existence of architecture and water. Inside, you'll find not only the offices, conference rooms and halls typical of a town hall. In the Blue Room, for example, there is a great banquet held every year for the Nobel Prize winners. Wander through the narrow streets of the historic quarter in Gamla Stan on the island of Stadsholmen. In the next few

days, discover one of the largest and best preserved medieval cities in Europe! In the evening there's a personal tourist information event and if you've booked bikes, they will be provided then.

Day 2: Excursion to Drottningholm Castle, approx. 50 km

First you'll be cycling along the Mälaren, Sweden's third largest lake, to Lovön island. This is where the royal Drottningholm Castle is – also known as the Swedish Versailles. It is the Royal Family's private residence – the castle in Stockholm is merely the official residence.

With such a majestic start to the today, why not continue in the same vein and visit Stockholm Castle in the afternoon? With 600 rooms, it is one of Europe's biggest palaces. It is home to many different museums, the treasury and armoury and every day in front of the palace you can see the changing of the guards. By the way, the original castle was destroyed in 1697 by a fire. No-one died in the fire. But as the fire became uncontained, the decision was taken to throw all valuables out of the windows to save them from the flames. In the process, a heavy bible landed on someone's head – and they died.

Day 3: Train ride Stockholm – Gothenburg

After breakfast, you will travel to Gothenburg by train with your own luggage. In the afternoon there is time to explore various sights of Gothenburg on foot. Discover Sweden's second largest city on a boat tour from the water, visit the harbor with its walk-in historic ships, the Maritiman adventure museum is also worth seeing. Enjoy a cinnamon bun in the popular district of Hage and stroll along the magnificent Kungsporsavenyn street. Garden lovers can visit the Trädgårdsföreningen park, while art lovers can visit the Gothenburg Art Museum.

Day 4: Gothenburg – Kungsbacka, approx. 40 – 65 km

At the hotel you will get new bikes for the next stages of your bike tour from Stockholm to Copenhagen. On Kattegattleden you cycle pleasantly flat past rocks and forests, bays and harbours. After visiting the impressive old town in Kungsbacka, it's time for a fika, as the Swedes call their coffee break. Accompanied by a few delicacies like havreflarn or kanelbullar – that's how the day can end.

Day 5: Kungsbacka – Varberg, approx. 60 – 75 km

The salty air of the sea blows around your nose while you enjoy the breathtaking view. You cycle along horse farms and fields to the small town of Åsa. Take a refreshing dip in the sea or walk along the beautiful beach before getting back on your bike. You will recognise your stage destination Varberg from far away. The fortress of the same name was built on a hill directly on the coast and is certainly worth a visit.

Day 6: Varberg – Falkenberg – Helsingborg, approx. 40 km + train ride

Look forward to picturesque fishing villages and many artisans today. If you have always wanted to try freshly cooked lobster, you can do so in Träslövsläge. Continue cycling to Falkenberg, one of the oldest towns in Halland province. Hop on the train (not included) and in about 90 minutes you will reach the harbour town of Helsingborg. This important city is situated at the narrowest point of the Øresund. Stroll through the old town or enjoy the evening at the large harbour.

Day 7: Helsingborg – Helsingør – Copenhagen, approx. 55 km + ferry ride

After breakfast, you'll be on Danish soil in just 20 minutes by ferry (not included). Follow in Shakespeare's footsteps and visit Kronborg Castle in Helsingør, the setting for the drama Hamlet. Then cycle along beautiful beaches and fragrant forests to the vibrant capital of Denmark. The city itself is as colourful as the houses in Nyhavn. Discover Amalienborg Castle, the home of Denmark's Queen Margrethe II and soak up the impressions of your bike tour from Stockholm to Copenhagen with a Smørrebrød.

Day 8: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
