Journey to Kalavárda

→ Nearest airports: Rhodes, Athens, Thessaloniki

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival on the island of Rhodes, transfer to Kalavarda

Arrival on Rhodes. The transfer from the airport to the hotel is included. If the bike is already available and time permits, you can explore the surrounding area or relax on the beach after the stresses and strains of travelling.

Day 2: Round trip in Kalavarda, approx. 35 km

Today you drive from Kalavarda along the barely inhabited north coast. Take the coastal road towards the archaeological site of the ancient city-state of Kamiros, which you may be able to visit on the way back. The quaint café „Mandriko“ invites you to take a coffee break. Take a look at the beautiful church next to the café. Head down a hill to the small fishing harbour of Skala Kamiros. Small boats leave here for Halki, a small island. From Skala, take a detour to the medieval fortress of Kritinia. Over the fortress walls you have a marvellous view of the small island of Halki and other small uninhabited islands. You cycle back to Skala and then the same route back to Kalavarda, now with the sun behind you and mostly with a tailwind. Back at the hotel there is an included dinner.

Day 3: Kalavarda – Petaloudes – Rhodes town, approx. 45 km

You drive northwards along the coast. You will pass through the unique village of Fanes with its colourful houses. Then drive inland to the Petaloudes Valley (Greek for butterflies). In the lush, beautiful gorge you can admire thousands of butterflies in the summer months (from around the end of June to mid-September). Through a wooded area you come to Maritsa and further north to Pastida, where there are

excellent tavernas. You enter Rhodes Town through a large gate and drive through the medieval town to your hotel, which is located within the old town walls.

Day 4: Excursion to Symi, approx. 25 km + + ferry rides

We have created a nice description that will take you through the old town with its well-known sights, but also to hidden alleys and other beautiful locations. Another option for today is to take the ferry (not included) to the island of Symi (depending on ferry availability). You will arrive at Panormitis Monastery in the south. You cross the island (22 km and 500 metres in altitude) to the main town of Symi, where the ferry (not included) departs for Rhodes again in the afternoon. Symi is a very picturesque and photogenic island.

Day 5: Rhodes town – Archangellos, approx. 40 km

Today you drive along the east coast. The first highlight is the former Turkish baths of Kallithea, which have recently been beautifully restored. In Afandou you drive along deserted beaches. On the horizon you can soon see the Tsambika monastery on a 300 metre high cliff. Today's destination is Archangellos, a lively Greek village.

Day 6: Excursion to Lindos, approx. 50 km

Today you can take a rest day and cycle to Stegna beach (3 km). You can also take a nice tour to Lindos (by bike or by bus). Lindos is a beautiful little village with white cubist houses at the foot of a vertical cliff crowned by the ancient acropolis of Lindos. There are two small

harbours on either side of the village. Together with the acropolis on top, it was easy to defend the village in ancient times. After you have parked your bike at the entrance to the village, you can visit the acropolis with the remains of the ancient temples in a medieval fortress.

Day 7: Archangellos – Kalavarda, approx. 40 km

Today you first drive to Epta Piges, a place in the forest with seven springs, a taverna and a few peacocks. Then it's downhill through a lush valley to the monastery of Agios Nektarios with its refreshing fountain

and a huge plane tree. Eleousa is a unique village, built about 80 years ago by Italians. Unfortunately, most of the houses are abandoned and dilapidated. A beautiful road leads you along the mountainside to the oldest Byzantine chapel on Rhodes: Fountoukli. Then it's all downhill via the village of Dimilia and past the Silas chapel built into a cave down to Soroni on the west coast and then on to Kalavarda.

Day 8: Transfer Kalavarda – Airport and individual departure

Your cycle tour in Greece ends after breakfast. You will be taken to the airport in the morning. You will then travel home individually.
