This tour starts in Porto, Portugal, and takes you to one of the most important cities of Christianity, Santiago de Compostela, Spain. Most of the time you cycle along the beautiful coastal landscapes of the Atlantic and get to know traditional fishing ports as well as picturesque villages and historic towns on the way. You will mainly follow the almost ascent-free course of the Portuguese Way of St. James, which connects two countries and cultures on this journey.

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Porto

After your arrival at Porto airport, the adventure of your cycling holiday in Portugal can begin! You will be transferred to your booked hotel, from where you can visit the former cultural capital either on foot or already from the saddle of your rental bike. The historic centre and the Douro riverbank on the Gaia side, where the port wine cellars are located, are classified as World Heritage Sites. Discover the lively city where the train station is housed in a former monastery and the facades of the houses are so colourful that they immediately put you in a good mood! Optional wine tasting in a historic wine cellar in Porto (Not included in the tour price).

Day 2: Porto – Caminha, approx. 50 km + Transfer

The first section of today's stage of your cycle tour on the Portuguese Way of St James is completed with a transfer (included), which takes you to Esposende. Let's get going! A first stopover is in Viana do Castelo. Visit the Praça da República, one of the most beautiful medieval squares in Portugal, and enjoy an outstanding view of the city and the River Lima from the pilgrimage church on Monte Santa Luzia. We continue along the Atlantic coast to Caminha. The town is surrounded by a mighty city wall, behind which you will discover small, picturesque alleyways.

Day 3: Caminha - Baiona, approx. 40 km

Right at the start of your cycling day today, you are spoilt for choice: you can cross the Rio Minho by ferry (not included) or cycle over the Ponte da Amizade bridge in Vila Nova de Cerveira to the other bank of the river. In both cases, you cross the border to Spain almost unnoticed. You continue cycling along the Atlantic coast to your destination for the day, the harbour town of Baiona. After a stroll through the town, savour freshly caught seafood, sit back with a glass of wine and enjoy the view of the sea at sunset.

Day 4: Baiona - Pontevedra, approx. 30 km

Today's cycling day on the Portuguese Way of St James takes you along the Atlantic coast of Galicia. Along the way, enjoy the view over the sea and the fresh sea breeze blowing in your face. Along the way, oyster lovers will get their money's worth in the fishing village of Arcade. Your destination for the day, Pontevedra, is a town steeped in history with a long seafaring and trading tradition. Take a tour of the town, which is characterised by numerous squares, churches and museums - well worth seeing!

Day 5: Pontevedra - Cambados, approx. 30 km

You cycle at a relaxed pace towards the Atlantic, passing the vineyards of the Rías Baixas. The wine region is known for Albariño, one of Portugal's most important white wine varieties. In your destination for the day, Cambados, wine-growing and fishing are omnipresent. Stroll along

the Praza de Fefiñans, visit the fishing district of San Tomé and enjoy a guided tour of a traditional winery, including a wine tasting (included) of Galicia's tangy, fresh wine.

Day 6: Cambados - Carril, approx. 40 km

Your cycle tour on the Portuguese Way of St James takes you to the wide estuary of the Ría de Arousa, a bay. Cross a bridge to reach the small island of A Illa de Arousa. Enjoy sunbathing on the kilometre-long sandy beaches or treat yourself to a refreshing dip in the sea. From the Con do Forno viewpoint, you can enjoy a beautiful view over the island. Back on the mainland, we head to Carril. The fishing village is famous for its mussels, which are farmed on wooden platforms off the coast - try them!

Day 7: Carril - Santiago de Compostela, approx. 45 km

Today you cycle inland through forests and wetlands and first reach Padrón. Legend has it that the ship carrying the body of St James the Apostle, who was later buried in Santiago de Compostela, docked in this small town. Over the centuries, Santiago de Compostela has developed into one of the most important pilgrimage destinations in the world. The cathedral, which was built in the 11th century as the burial church of St James, is particularly impressive. On the last evening of your cycle tour on the Portuguese Way of St James, treat yourself to typical Spanish empanadas and a Galician wine - perfecto!

Day 8: Transfer Santiago de Compostela – Porto and individual departure

Your cycle tour on the Portuguese Way of St James ends after breakfast. A transfer (included) will take you from Santiago de Compostela to Porto airport.

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
