Your tour

Over the turquoise waters of the Mediterranean Sea, you will sail through the Kvarner Bay on your motor sailer in complete relaxation. Krk, Rab and Cres are among the most beautiful islands of the western Adriatic. On land, you cycle to secluded bays, get to know the historic town centres of old harbour towns, wave to grazing sheep as you pass by and relax under shady pine trees.

You can book the trip by bike and boat in Croatia in two different categories: In the comfort category, you travel on the motor sailers Planka, Kažimir and Sveti Vid. You will find more comfort in the premium category on the motorsailer Aria.

Journey to Rijeka

- Nearest airport: Rijeka
- A transfer can be booked from the airport to the boat and back upon request and provision of the flight number and arrival time. The price for the transfer will be determined and communicated at the beginning of 2026.

Parking in Rijeka

- Guarded parking spaces in Rijeka, cost 79 € per week/car, 185 € per week/Camper van up to 5 metres, 99 € for all vehicles over 5 metres in length, payable in advance. The car park reservation must be made at the time of booking.

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Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival to Rijeka, Rijeka – Island of Krk (boat), bike tour Krk, approx. 20 km

Embarkation between 11:00 and 12:00 in Rijeka. There will be a welcome by the tour guide with welcome drink and snack. In the afternoon, the ship takes you to Njivice on the island of Krk, where you start your first cycling tour. From Njivice you will cycle to Porat and back. You will spend the night in the port of Njivice.

Day 2: Bike tour on the island of Krk, approx. 45 km

After breakfast, we cycle from Njivice via Dobrinj to Vrbnik. The old town is situated on a rock on the east coast – just made for souvenir photos! The area is famous for the golden-coloured Zlahtina, a wine from the surrounding vineyards. Strengthened, we head uphill to the highest point of today's stage. From here you have a magnificent view of the Baška valley, which stretches all the way to the southern end of the island. Then you will roll downhill to the harbour town of Krk. Your ship is already waiting for you there. You will spend the night in the harbour of Krk.

Day 3: Island Krk – Island of Rab (boat), bike tour of Rab, approx. 40 km

A short boat ride takes you to Lopar, on the northern tip of the island of Rab. You will then cycle across the island, whose landscape is very contrasting: the side facing the Adriatic Sea is lushly forested, while the side facing the mainland of Croatia is very barren. The most beautiful town on the island is Rab, your destination, which you reach already around noon. Pretty little towers adorn the old town. After lunch on

board, you can explore the 1400-hectare Kalifront forest park with its holm oaks that are up to 1,000 years old. After the guided tour of Rab, you can have dinner in one of the restaurants.

Day 4: Island Rab – Island of Pag (boat), bike tour Pag, approx. 35 km, Pag – Olib island or Ilovik (boat)

Today you will explore the island of Pag by bike and boat in Croatia. First you will sail from Rab to the northernmost tip of Lun and then get on your bike. Olive trees, lush meadows and stone landscapes accompany you to Novalja, where you take a break. After lunch on board, the journey continues to a bay, where an extensive swimming break is on the programme. For the overnight stay, the captain sets course for the islands of Olib or Ilovik. In the evening, the Captain's Dinner will take place on board.

Day 5: Island Olib – Island of Lošinj (boat), bike tour Lošinj, approx. 20 km

The day begins in a relaxed way with a crossing to the next island: Lošinj. Enjoy the view of Croatia from the water! On the way in a bay, have a delicious lunch on board. Finally arrived, you cycle through deep green pine forests and past romantic bays. Colourful flowers accompany your cycle tour across one of the sunniest places in Europe! The highlight of the round tour is the beautiful harbour town of Veli Lošinj. Back in Mali Lošinj you have the opportunity to have dinner in one of the numerous restaurants.

Day 6: Island of Lošinj – Island of Cres, approx. 55 km

Today you will not travel to the island of Cres by boat, but by bike. Both islands are connected by a bridge. You cycle from your ship to Osor, where you cross the swing bridge to the island of Cres. Your destination is the picturesque town of Cres. Around Cres there are beautiful beaches, which remind you of the Caribbean with their azure blue water. You will have enough time in the afternoon to discover them on your own. In the evening, the crew will be waiting for you with the captain's dinner.

Day 7: Bike tour on the island of Cres, approx. 10 km / 50 hm, Cres – Rijeka (boat)

The last stage of your bike and boat holiday in Croatia consists of a round trip from Cres Town to the village of Predošćica. There is a viewpoint where a magnificent view over the Adriatic Sea and the islands of Croatia awaits you. After lunch on board, your ship will drop anchor in a turquoise blue bay. Take advantage of the last bathing opportunity before you head for Rijeka.

Day 8: Individual departure from Rijeka

Disembarkation takes place after breakfast until 09:00. Afterwards you start your individual journey home or transfer to the airport.

Boat descriptions



MS Planka – Comfort category

After captain Jure Tomaš installed a new engine in his MS Planka, the ship was completely reconstructed in 2005. Meanwhile Jure's elder son Marin is at the helm of this classic wooden ship. You will travel personally taken care of by the crew, who will cook delicious regional dishes for you every day. On the huge sun deck you can relax and if it gets too hot, just jump directly from the ship into the crystal clear Mediterranean Sea to refresh yourself.

- 11 outside cabins, approx. 5 m²
- Equipment cabins: Shower / WC
- Lower deck: 4 triple cabins with French bed and 3rd bed above, there are ventilation shafts
- Main deck: 3 double cabins with bunk beds, portholes can be opened
- Upper deck: 4 double cabins with french be, opening windows. Cabins are allocated on site.
- Built in 1957
- Renovated in 2005
- 3 passenger decks
- Maximum occupancy: 24 passengers
- Length: 27 m
- Width: 6 m
- Facilities: sun deck about 100 m² with deck chairs, tables with benches on deck, air-conditioned salon

MS Sveti Vid, comfort category

Formerly a prisoner transport ship, today a floating hotel for vacationers! The three-master Sveti Vid takes its guests through the islands off the Croatian coast and offers simple but cozy cabins on two decks. The sun deck is the perfect place to relax, soak up the sun and enjoy the relaxed feeling of the sea, while the ship's crew and experienced captain ensure that you want for nothing.

- 16 outside cabins
- Cabin facilities: Shower/WC, individually adjustable air conditioning
- Main deck:
 - 5 double cabins with single beds
 - 1 triple cabins with French bed (140 cm) and 3rd bed above
- Upper deck:

 - 2 triple cabins with French bed (130 cm) and 3rd bed above

MS Kazimir, comfort category

Kažo - known as Braco - has been in command of the MS Kazimir together with his wife Zdenka since 2016. The large wooden ship offers an amazing amount of space and comfort for a cozy bike cruise on the large sun deck and the seating area on the upper deck.

 - 6 triple cabins with French bed and 3rd bed above

MS Aria – Premium category

Since his son took over the helm of the MS Planka in 2015, Captain Jure Tomaš has been taking care of his new ship, the MS Aria. Aria, by the way, stands for air in the Dalmatian dialect. The majestic motor sailer set sail for the first time in spring 2016. Look forward to sailing on a new, comfortable ship, be pampered by the crew and relax in a deck chair on the large sun deck from the wonderful cycling tours. The jump into the crystal clear water can be done comfortably from the bathing platform.

Facts about the ship:

- 18 outside cabins, approx. 9 - 13 m²
- Equipment cabins: Shower / WC, individually controlled air conditioning
- Lower deck:
 - 2 triple cabins with two single beds and a third bed above,
 - 4 double cabins with french bed,
 - 2 double cabins with single beds that can be pushed together to form a double bed
- Main deck:
 - 6 double cabins with French bed
- Upper deck:
 - 4 double cabins with single beds that can be pushed together to form a double bed.
- The cabin allocation is done on the spot.
- The portholes in the cabins on the main deck can be opened
- On the lower deck there is a ventilation system that provides fresh air even when the portholes are closed
- Built in 2016
- 3 passenger decks
- Maximum occupancy: 40 passengers
- Length: 43 m
- Width: 8,50 m
- Facilities: 2 showers / WC, sun deck about 250 m² with deck chairs, tables with benches and chairs on the covered main deck, air-conditioned salon, bathing platform with showers at the stern.
