Your tour

Cycling is exceptionally in the background on this bathing cruise: you are not only on the saddle, but also on foot and by kayak. Be it a city tour, a short hike, a visit to a fragrant garden or a kayak tour through the Zrmanja Canyon. Of course, swimming is not neglected either: as soon as the ship is at anchor, you can jump straight from it into the crystal-clear waves of the Adriatic! The daily excursions on the islands of the Kvarner Bay have one thing in common: they are relaxed and can be managed comfortably even by families and the inexperienced.

You can book the leisure Cruise in Croatia in two different categories: In the comfort category, you travel on the motor sailers Planka, Kažimir and Sveti Vid. You will find more comfort in the premium category on the motorsailer Aria.

- 11 – 18 Outside cabins, approx. 5 – 13 m², depending on ship
- 2 passenger decks (main and upper deck, MS Sveti Vid, MS Kazimir)
- 3 passenger decks (lower, main and upper deck, MS Planka, MS Aria)
- Cabin equipment: Bathroom with shower / WC, Partial air conditioning
- Partially opening portholes or windows and ventilation shafts, depending on the ship and deck

Journey to Rijeka

- Nearest airport: Rijeka
- A transfer can be booked from the airport to the boat and back upon request and provision of the flight number and arrival time. The price for the transfer will be determined and communicated at the beginning of 2026.

Parking in Rijeka

- Guarded parking spaces in Rijeka, cost 79 € per week/car, 185 € per week/Camper van up to 5 metres, 99 € for all vehicles over 5 metres in length, payable in advance. The car park reservation must be made at the time of booking.

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Rijeka, Rijeka – Cres Island (boat), bike tour on Cres, approx. 15 km

The crew of your ship will be waiting for you in the port of Rijeka between 8.30 and 12.00! Over a welcome drink you will get to know the crew and fellow passengers while your romantic motor sailer sets sail for the first time. On the way, a stop will be made in one of the bays so that you can take that long-awaited, first plunge into the sea! Once on the island of Cres, you can join in a walk by the sea. After dinner, there will be plenty of time for a stroll around town.

Day 2: Cres island - Lošinj island (boat), swimming, bike tour approx. 5 km and hike Veli Lošinj

During the crossing to the island of Lošinj, you will observe the passing Kvarner Bay. With a bit of luck, you might spot a group of Adriatic dolphins today. After lunch on board, you will moor in the harbour of Mali Lošinj. You can then join a leisurely hike to the picturesque village of Veli Lošinj. On the way back, you will visit a nearby „Mediterranean Fragrance Garden“. During a guided tour, you will learn more about the 250 or so different fragrant plants that grow and thrive in the garden.

Day 3: Lošinj island – Zadar (boat), Bike tour approx. 20 km, swimming and town tour

During a relaxed bike ride on the saddle you will explore the unspoilt island of Molat. You will be back on board in time for lunch. During the crossing to Zadar you will take an extensive bathing break in a bay. The old town of Zadar, your destination today, is surrounded by mighty

walls. During an entertaining guided tour of the city, you will learn all kinds of interesting facts about the time-honoured buildings and their history.

Day 4: Zadar – Zrmanja Canyon – Zadar, Kayak tour to waterfalls

Today you leave the sea and paddle along the Zrmanja river to the canyon of the same name. A bus transfer will take you to the entry point, where you will also pick up your kayak. The karst river glistens in its typical emerald green color, a wonderful sight! After a few bends and rapids, magical waterfalls await you at one of the most beautiful spots on the river. After a picnic, you paddle on through the Zrmanja canyon. After the tour, the bus will take you back to Zadar. Note: If the water level is very high, the excursion is carried out in large inflatable boats (rafting).

Day 5: Zadar – Pag island – Island of Rab (boat), olive grove, swimming break, city tour

Today you take a closer look at the island of Pag with its partly barren, partly lush green meadows: you sail to Lun on the north-western tip of the island. Around 80,000 olive trees grow here! And even more impressive: some of them are already around 1200 years old! You will learn all this and more during a guided tour of the grove. After an extensive swimming break, the boat sets sail for the island of Rab. The old town of the main town stretches across a long headland and is home to a number of sights.

Day 6: Bike tour on Rab, approx. 15 km, island of Rab – island of Krk (boat), swimming break and walk

After breakfast, we go on an easy bike tour across the Suha Punta peninsula, which is densely covered in pine trees, to Frkanj Beach. Back on board, we immediately head for one of the many secluded bays. The next destination is the island of Krk, one of the largest islands in the Adriatic. You can round off the evening in one of the many restaurants with a view of the sea.

Day 7: Bike tour on Krk, approx. 5 km, island of Krk – Rijeka (boat), stroll through the town, swimming break

Our ship sets sail for Haludovo. On a leisurely cycle tour from Haludovo to Njivice, we follow the so-called Paradise Trail along the coast - with sweeping views of the sea and shady sections through fragrant pine forests. After lunch on board, we return to the starting point of the trip - with a stop for a swim in one of the bays before we spend the night in Rijeka harbour.

Day 8: Individual departure from Rijeka

Disembarkation takes place after breakfast until 09:00. Afterwards you start your individual journey home or transfer to the airport.

MS Planka – Comfort category

After captain Jure Tomaš installed a new engine in his MS Planka, the ship was completely reconstructed in 2005. Meanwhile Jure's elder son Marin is at the helm of this classic wooden ship. You will travel personally taken care of by the crew, who will cook delicious regional dishes for you every day. On the huge sun deck you can relax and if it gets too hot, just jump directly from the ship into the crystal clear Mediterranean Sea to refresh yourself.

- 11 outside cabins, approx. 5 m²
- Equipment cabins: Shower / WC
- Lower deck: 4 triple cabins with French bed and 3rd bed above, there are ventilation shafts
- Main deck: 3 double cabins with bunk beds, portholes can be opened
- Upper deck: 4 double cabins with french be, opening windows. Cabins are allocated on site.
- Built in 1957
- Renovated in 2005
- 3 passenger decks
- Maximum occupancy: 24 passengers
- Length: 27 m
- Width: 6 m
- Facilities: sun deck about 100 m² with deck chairs, tables with benches on deck, air-conditioned salon
- Board languages: English, German

MS Sveti Vid, comfort category

Formerly a prisoner transport ship, today a floating hotel for vacationers! The three-master Sveti Vid takes its guests through the islands off the Croatian coast and offers simple but cozy cabins on two decks. The sun deck is the perfect place to relax, soak up the sun and enjoy the relaxed feeling of the sea, while the ship's crew and experienced captain ensure that you want for nothing.

Facts about the ship:

- 16 outside cabins
- Cabin facilities: Shower/WC, individually adjustable air conditioning
- Main deck:
 - 5 double cabins with single beds
 - 1 triple cabins with French bed (140 cm) and 3rd bed above
- Upper deck:
 - 2 double cabins with single beds
 - 4 double cabins with French bed
 - 2 triple cabins with French bed (130 cm) and 3rd bed above
 - 2 triple cabins with French bed (140 cm) and 3rd bed above
- Cabin allocation takes place on site
- Built in 1955
- Renovation in 2017
- Maximum occupancy: 37 passengers

MS Kažimir, comfort category

Kažo - known as Braco - has been in command of the MS Kažimir together with his wife Zdenka since 2016. The large wooden ship offers an amazing amount of space and comfort for a cozy bike cruise on the large sun deck and the seating area on the upper deck.

- 15 outside cabins: approx. 9 m²
- Cabin facilities: Shower/WC, individually adjustable air conditioning
- Main deck:
 - 6 triple cabins with French bed and 3rd bed above
 - 2 double cabins with French bed
- Upper deck:

 - 3 double cabins with bunk beds
- Cabin allocation is done on site
- The portholes or windows of the cabins can be opened
- Built in 1946
- Completely rebuilt in 1999 / 2000, renovated in 2019

MS Aria – Premium category

Since his son took over the helm of the MS Planka in 2015, Captain Jure Tomaš has been taking care of his new ship, the MS Aria. Aria, by the way, stands for air in the Dalmatian dialect. The majestic motor sailer set sail for the first time in spring 2016. Look forward to sailing on a new, comfortable ship, be pampered by the crew and relax in a deck chair on the large sun deck from the wonderful cycling tours. The jump into the crystal clear water can be done comfortably from the bathing platform.

Facts about the ship:

- 18 outside cabins, approx. 9 - 13 m²
- Equipment cabins: Shower / WC, individually controlled air conditioning
- Lower deck:
 - 2 triple cabins with two single beds and a third bed above,
 - 4 double cabins with french bed,
 - 2 double cabins with single beds that can be pushed together to form a double bed
- Main deck:
 - 6 double cabins with French bed
- Upper deck:
 - 4 double cabins with single beds that can be pushed together to form a double bed.
- The cabin allocation is done on the spot.
- The portholes in the cabins on the main deck can be opened
- On the lower deck there is a ventilation system that provides fresh air even when the portholes are closed
- Built in 2016
- 3 passenger decks
- Maximum occupancy: 40 passengers
- Length: 43 m
- Width: 8,50 m
- Facilities: 2 showers / WC, sun deck about 250 m² with deck chairs, tables with benches and chairs on the covered main deck, air-conditioned salon, bathing platform with showers at the stern.
