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## Stages description

### Day 1: Individual arrival in Parma

### Day 2: Parma – Torrechiara – Parma, approx. 55 km

Rolling hills, vineyards and picturesque villages shape this day of your Cycling Holiday in Emilia-Romagna. The route leads you through the land of the famous Parma ham towards the striking Torrechiara Castle, perched above the surrounding countryside. Scenic views accompany you throughout the ride before returning to Parma.

### Day 3: Parma – Reggio Emilia, approx. 55 km, Parma – Reggio Emilia, approx. 55 km

Today you cycle through peaceful countryside renowned for producing Parmigiano Reggiano. Quiet roads connect charming villages and historic sites, offering an authentic glimpse into rural Italian life. Reggio Emilia welcomes you with its rich heritage and its role in Italian history.

### Day 4: Reggio Emilia – Modena, approx. 55 km, Reggio Emilia – Modena, approx. 55 km

Open plains, cultivated landscapes and a strong culinary tradition define this stage of your Cycling Holiday in Emilia-Romagna. Passing through delightful towns such as Correggio and Carpi, you gradually approach Modena, a city celebrated for its art, architecture and vibrant atmosphere.
