Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Udine

Welcome to the capital of Friuli Venezia Giulia! Experience the lively hustle and bustle of the green city and enjoy your first evening in "Bella Italia".

Day 2: Udine - San Daniele del Friuli, approx. 45 km

Leave the city on the well-known Alpe-Adria Cycle Path and cycle the first few kilometres north. The mighty mountain range of the Carnic Alps towers over the gently undulating landscape, with beautiful panoramas opening up again and again. From the Castello di Colloredo di Monte Albano, you can enjoy a breathtaking view over the lowlands, before continuing by bike through the medieval town of Fagagna. In San Daniele del Friuli, famous for its ham, you will be overwhelmed by the picturesque old town with its imposing cathedral and bell tower.

Day 3: San Daniele del Friuli – Codroipo, approx. 55 km

After breakfast, you leave the hilltop "ham capital" and head towards the Tagliamento river. This Alpine river, shimmering in all kinds of colours, forms a unique landscape of poplars, alders and willows. At a narrow point, you cross the river over an impressive bridge before taking a break in the beautiful old town centre of Spilimbergo, the city of mosaic art. The route continues at a leisurely pace through typical Italian villages to Codroipo.

Day 4: Codroipo - Marano Lagunare / Lignano, approx. 50 km

Just outside the town of Codroipo, marvel at Villa Manin, the summer residence of the last Venetian doge, before heading towards the coast through the cultural landscape and along the Tagliamento river cycle path. In Latisana, founded in Roman times, with its large number of sacred buildings, you can already smell the sea. A few kilometres

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further on, your eyes will also be treated to a view of the lagoon. In Marano Lagunare, stroll through the small alleyways of the picturesque old town centre in the evening. Overnight stay in Lignano also possible.

Day 5: Marano Lagunare - Grado, approx. 40 - 70 km

Cycle along the lagoon to Cervignano del Friuli and on to Aquileia, famous for its medieval basilica and Roman archaeological site, which has been a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1998. After an extensive sightseeing tour, you cycle along the Alpe-Adria cycle path to the lagoon town of Grado on the island off the coast. Enjoy a swim in the Adriatic Sea and dinner in the winding old town centre.

Day 6: Grado - Gradisca d'Isonzo, approx. 50 km

You leave Grado along the lagoon and cycle through a nature reserve by the sea. Observe the species-rich birdlife and feel the sea breeze blowing around your nose before heading back inland. Close to the Slovenian border, you will spend the night in the town of Gradisca d'Isonzo, which is characterised by four eras. Stroll through the streets

of the town of 6,000 inhabitants, a member of the association "I borghi più belli d'Italia", the most beautiful villages in Italy, and round off the evening with a glass of wine in a cosy restaurant.

Day 7: Gradisca d'Isonzo – Udine, approx. 65 km

As you drive northwards, the border with Slovenia draws ever closer, the vineyards of the famous Collio region grow ever larger, as do your eyes, because this hilly wine landscape looks like something out of a picture book. Take the opportunity to taste the wine produced here directly from a winegrower. There are plenty of wonderful places to stop for refreshments here. Before returning to the starting point in Udine, you should plan a stopover in Cividale del Friuli. Stroll through the narrow streets, take a photo of the Devil's Bridge and take a look inside the cathedral. There is a lot to discover.

Day 8: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.

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
