Your tour

The northern Black Forest is characterized by its expressive and diverse landscape. Marked by dense forests, deep valleys and gorges, rushing rivers and a unique wildlife, it belongs to Germany's most popular holiday regions. From Freudenstadt, you get to know the spa town Bad Wildbad, the Kinzig valley around Hausach, the wine paradise Ortenau and the former residence town Rastatt. On your way, you must pedal strongly a few times, but don't worry, magnificent views and the enjoyable Black Forest kitchen compensate you for the struggles.

Journey to Freudenstadt

- Closest airports: Frankfurt, Stuttgart, Strasbourg, Karlsruhe
- Train station: Freudenstadt

Parking in Freudenstadt

- Public parking garage at the market place, cost approx. 22 Euro / week.
- Hotel parking spaces (available in individual hotels, chargeable, details in the travel documents).

Bike handover

- Arrival: Guests' rental bikes will be available at the arrival hotel.
Departure: The guests leave the bikes at the last hotel. If an e-bike has been rented, the battery, charger and key must be returned to the reception.

Luggage transport

- Luggage pick-up from 09.00 a.m., delivery to the next hotel by 06.00 p.m. at the latest, labeling of luggage is 1 x for the whole tour. No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but max. 20 kg per piece of luggage.

Travel documents

- 1 set (per booked room) consists of: hotel list and voucher, travel information with details on daily stages, short travel guides and route descriptions, maps, luggage tags
- Dispatch up to four weeks before arrival. For bookings at short notice, handover on site, voucher and arrival information in advance by e-mail.

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Freudenstadt

Freudenstadt is your base for the next three cycling stages. Germany's largest marketplace with its water fountains wants to be explored. Here you find small stores and cafés in the arcades, inviting you to stroll and linger.

Day 2: Freudenstadt – Hausach / Wolfach, approx. 45 km

At the beginning of the day, you have to climb a few meters. In the half-timbered town of Alpirsbach, however, you have completed the most strenuous part of the day. Famous for the beer of the same name, the former monastery town is the ideal place for your lunch break. You continue on the Kinzigtal cycle path to Wolfach or Hausach.

Day 3: Hausach – Durbach / Appenweier, approx. 50 / 55 km

Your cycle tour continues along the Kinzig today. The history of the town of Haslach dates back to Roman times. The route continues via Steinach, Biberach and Gengenbach to Ohlsbach, where the Kinzig valley merges into the Rhine plain. In Offenburg, you can take a short break in the small old town centre. You reach Durbach and Appenweier via the Ortenau vineyards.

Day 4: Appenweier – Rastatt, approx. 50 / 60 km

From Durbach or Appenweier, you cycle northwards along the edge of the Rhine plain. The route takes you past the hills of the foothills of the Central/North Black Forest Nature Park. If you wish, you can make a detour to Baden-Baden, the famous spa town. You will spend the night in the former royal seat of Rastatt, which impresses with its baroque buildings.

Day 5: Rastatt – Ettlingen, approx. 45 km

Today you cycle to Karlsruhe. The city has a fan-shaped ground plan with the Karlsruhe Castle in the center. After leaving Karlsruhe, you soon reach Ettlingen - your destination for today. An evening walk through the historic center will take you past many old half-timbered houses and town houses.

Day 6: Ettlingen – Bad Wildbad, approx. 35 km

Today you have a great panoramic view of the Black Forest at the Schwanner Warte near Straubenhardt. From Neuenbürg you cycle in the opposite direction of the Enz river, following in the footsteps of the Enz valley rafters. In the rafting museum in Calmbach you can learn more about the region, which is characterized by forestry and timber industry

Day 7: Bad Wildbad – Freudenstadt, approx. 50 km + cable car

At the beginning of the day, you board the Sommerbergbahn and ride up to the high plateau of the Sommerberg. Here it is worth taking a walk on the tree-top walkway with the Wildline suspension bridge arching upward. It offers fantastic views of the surrounding hills and valleys of the northern Black Forest. You then cycle along the Black Forest Panorama Cycle Path to Freudenstadt.

Day 8: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
