Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Utrecht

Picturesque parks and canals, historic buildings and many interesting museums await you in Utrecht. In the vibrant city center, numerous restaurants and bars invite you to linger.

Day 2: Utrecht – Amsterdam, approx. 55 km

Following the course of the river Utrechtse Vecht you start your cycling trip. The region of the idyllic river offers a lot of culture and history. In the beautiful landscape you can relax in the best way. The rich gastronomic offer also contributes to this. Today's destination is the Dutch capital Amsterdam. Let the day end with a canal cruise.

Day 3: Amsterdam – Zandvoort, approx. 40 km

Stroll a bit through the narrow streets of the Dutch metropolis before you continue your bike tour. Soon you will reach Haarlem, which is ideal for a lunch break. In the idyllic city you will find some of Hollands characteristic windmills, canals and drawbridges. The last part of the tour takes you to the coast to Zandvoort. The extensive sandy beaches tempt you to take a swim.

Day 4: Zandvoort – Den Haag, approx. 50 km

Today will take you along the North Sea coast. Wonderful beach promenades invite you again and again to take a dip in the cool water. In spring, a short trip to Keukenhof is worthwhile. More than 7 million tulips, hyacinths and daffodils can be admired then. Today's stopover is The Hague. Wide sandy beaches, green parks and beautiful dunes characterize this city. Those interested in art and culture will also get their money's worth: a high-quality range of museums is available.

Day 5: Den Haag – Rotterdam, approx. 50 km

Now you are heading inland again, away from the coast. On your route you will quickly reach Delft. The university town is known far beyond its borders for Delft porcelain. In the Vermeer Center you can admire works by the painter Johannes Vermeer. In addition, the numerous cafes and restaurants invite you to linger. The cycling stage ends in the trendy port metropolis of Rotterdam. A paradise for shopping fans.

Day 6: Rotterdam – Gouda, approx. 55 km

After breakfast there will be enough time to stroll a little through Rotterdam. You will be captivated by the modern architecture. On the bike you will soon reach the windmills of Kinderdijk. The 19 impressive structures are among the most popular postcard motifs in the Netherlands. The famous windmills were built as early as 1740 and were declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1997. Through the water-rich nature, in the midst of picturesque landscapes, the further route leads you to Gouda.

Day 7: Gouda – Utrecht, approx. 50 km

Medieval Gouda is famous not only for its cheese, but also for its syrup waffles. You can convince yourself of this right away at breakfast. The last stage takes you to the green heart of the Netherlands. You will roam through extensive natural landscapes, picturesque villages and vast polders. In the historic city center of Utrecht, you will end the cycling stage with a refreshing beer.

Day 8: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
