Your tour

When you think of a Spreewald bike tour, you probably first think of paths along the famous cucumbers. In fact, however, the tour takes you into the wild nativeness of the Spreewald with its grandiose water labyrinth of natural and branched watercourses of the Spree. Postmen on yellow mail barges are as much a part of the region as the river meadows and moors with their unique flora and fauna. Cottbus is the cultural centre of the Sorbian minority. Baroque town houses, the English-inspired Branitz Park, Germany's oldest film theatre built in Art Nouveau style and the town houses of the immigrant French Huguenots characterise the city.

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Cottbus, excursion to Spremberg Lake, approx. 60 km

Arrival, get set, go! Cycle via the Kutzeburger Mühle riding and leisure centre to the large Spremberg reservoir. A little further east you come to the Bagenzer Teich. Fancy a cosy break on the beach and a dip in the water? Then head back through Branitz Park. This landscape park, designed by Prince Pückler in the English style, is particularly impressive with its grassy pyramids.

Day 2: Cottbus – Lübben, approx. 70 km

Today's stage on the Spree Cycle Route takes you from Cottbus to the Spreewald. Passing the Peitzer Teichen, Germany's largest pond area, you will reach the cultural landscape characterised by countless water

arms and picturesque villages. You will spend the night in Lübben. You should not miss out on a boat trip. Discover the water labyrinth of the Spreewald and enjoy the uniqueness of this natural landscape from the water.

Day 3: Lübben – Cottbus, approx. 50 km, individual departure

The 300 or so natural watercourses run through green meadows and fields like shimmering blue and white threads. You reach Lehde via Lübbenau. The village is criss-crossed by a fairytale labyrinth of water - the actual roads in the Spreewald. You cycle via the fishing village of Leipe to Burg and back to Cottbus on quiet paths. Your luggage will be waiting for you here, and we are also happy to extend your Spreewald cycle tour in Cottbus with an extra night.
