### Your tour

Cycle from the beautiful Upper Lusatian Mountains through traditional Sorbian countryside and unspoilt river landscapes to the Szczecin Lagoon. Cultural monuments worth seeing and omnipresent witnesses of recent history accompany you on your journey through the German-Polish border region to the bathtub of Berlin.

## Stages description

### Day 1: Individual arrival in Zittau

The most southeastern town in Saxony has a beautiful market square, where the town hall built by Schinkel is located. You can see the famous Zittau lenten cloths in two different museums. Enjoy the flair of this once Bohemian town and let the narrow-gauge railway take you to the surrounding spa towns to get in the mood for your holiday. Booked rental bikes are available at the hotel.

### Day 2: Zittau – Görlitz, approx. 40 km

Your first stage takes you to Hirschfelde. Further on, the Neisse accompanies you to the Cistercian monastery of St. Marienthal. The baroque style gives it an imposing appearance. Since 1234 until today, the oldest German house of this order has been in continuous use. With Görlitz you arrive in a place that was spared from war and therefore still has significant buildings from the Middle Ages, the Renaissance and Art Nouveau.

### Day 3: Görlitz – Bad Muskau, approx. 70 km

Continuing along the river, you will pass the Einsiedel Island of Culture at Zentendorf, where you can see a remarkable tree house hotel. Incidentally, you are not only in Upper Lusatia, but also in former Silesia, which jutted westwards across the Neisse. Prince Pückler lived in Muskau, where he created a unique park and gave his name to the famous ice cream.

### Day 4: Bad Muskau – Guben, approx. 65 km

After breakfast, you cycle further along the river. Via the Sorbian villages of Zelz and Bademeusel you reach Forst, the city of roses. In addition to impressive cloth factories, a textile museum and numerous churches, the reddish water tower is the town's landmark. Then the cycle path takes you past lakes and through extensive forests as well as the typical heath landscape to the twin town of Guben / Gubin.

**Day 5: Guben – Frankfurt (Oder), approx. 65 km**

If you don't have a sensitive stomach, you can immerse yourself in the world of anatomy after breakfast. The Plastinarium houses, among other things, the famous travelling exhibition Body Worlds. Continuing on your bike today, you will follow the Oder river, which you will meet shortly after Guben and which will lead you to the baroque monastery of Neuzelle. Treat yourself to a black beer brewed in the Cistercian tradition. You will reach Frankfurt via Eisenhüttenstadt.

**Day 6: Frankfurt (Oder) – Groß Neuendorf / Altlewin, approx. 60 / 70 km**

The birthplace of the important playwright Heinrich von Kleist was once an important trading and Hanseatic town. Impressive buildings such as the town hall and St. Mary's Church still bear witness to its former wealth. Today's stage takes you through the Oderbruch, a cultural landscape created in the 18th century by river straightening, embankment and drainage.

**Day 7: Groß Neuendorf – Schwedt / Oder, approx. 60 –75 km**

Whereas yesterday it was rural, today it is downright lonely in the Lower Oder Valley Nature Park, home to many rare plants and animals. The river floodplain is a resting place for large flocks of migratory birds. You will pass Stolpe Castle, which has one of the most massive defence towers in Germany, the Grützpott. You then reach Schwedt. Here you will find one of the largest remaining Jewish cemeteries in Brandenburg.

**Day 8: Schwedt – Löcknitz, approx. 75 km**

After breakfast, you cycle to Gartz, which lies in the middle of an end moraine landscape in the national park. Due to its strategically important location on the Oder River, the town has been the victim of warlike conflicts time and again. Inland through forests and fields, the place names point to the former Slavic settlements. Despite its name, which translates as Sumpfloch, Löcknitz is a thriving little town.

**Day 9: Löcknitz – Ueckermünde, approx. 60 km**

Small lakes and heath landscapes characterise today's stage, which takes you through Western Pomerania to the coast of the Szczecin Lagoon. The lagoon was originally a glacial lake and is now very rich in fish with a depth of about four metres. At the mouth of the Uecker River lies the former fishing town of Ueckermünde, now lovingly restored. The residential castle is one of the most important buildings here.

**Day 10: Ueckermünde – Insel Usedom, approx. 65 / 80 km + ferry ride**

First you cycle to Kamp, from where you take the boat to Karnin on the island of Usedom. Here you have a wonderful view over the lagoon and the Baltic Sea from Golm, the highest elevation on the island at 69 metres. Relax in one of the imperial spas and admire the spa architecture on the sunny island. Then cycle through sparse forests and along the wide Baltic Sea sandy beach to your overnight destination.

**Day 11: Individual departure**

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
