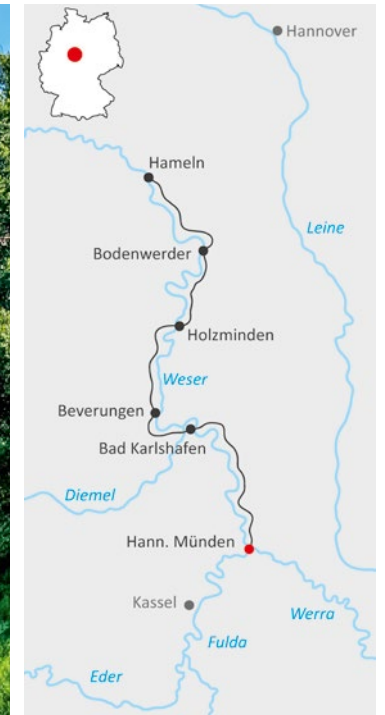

In Hann. Münden, the rivers Werra and Fulda join to form the Weser, which makes its way through the Weserbergland towards the North Sea. Marvel at the countless half-timbered houses in Hann. Münden, experience the beautiful buildings of the „Weser Baroque“ in Bad Karlshafen, visit the world-famous Corvey Monastery in Höxter, follow your nose through the „City of Scents and Aromas“ in Holzminden and follow in the footsteps of Münchhausen in Bodenwerder. Münchhausen’s footsteps. The destination of this almost climb-free journey is the „Pied Piper Town“ of Hameln.

- All bookings are on request.
- Return journey to Hann. Münden: Optionally with a minibus including bike, departure in Hameln approx. 16.00 o'clock, limited space, must be indicated when booking. You can also book the transfer from Hameln to Hann. Münden before the bike tour. This way you can continue your trip from Hameln right after the tour. Please write us your booking request in the online booking form in the free text field.
- Alternatively on your own by train, connections every 1 to 2 hours, at least 2 x changes, duration approx. 2.5 – 3 hours.
- Twin / double rooms / separate beds are only occasionally available. We treat requests as non-binding customer requests, if above mentioned room types are a booking condition, it must be mentioned as a condition at the time of booking.

Parking in Hann. Münden

- Category B: Public parking near the hotel, payable on site.
- Category A: Hotel parking for about 7 € / day or underground parking for about 17 € per day at the hotel, payable on site.
- No reservation by Radweg-Reisen possible.

Luggage transport

- Luggage pick-up from 09.00 a.m., delivery to the next hotel by 06.00 p.m. at the latest, labeling of luggage is 1 x for the whole tour. No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but max. 20 kg per piece of luggage.

Travel documents

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Hann. Münden

Hann. Münden, where the rivers Werra and Fulda unite to form the Weser, enchants visitors with its framework buildings: Here you will find fine specimens of the Weser Renaissance. Embedded in historical fortifications, the old Werra Bridge, the tremendous Welfen Castle and the town hall await enthusiastic visitors. Booked rental bikes will be available at the hotel.

Day 2: Hann. Münden – Bad Karlshafen / Beverungen, approx. 45 / 55 km

Your first stage of the tour leads you through the Hessen Weser-bergland region, past Reinhardshagen and the former Benedictine Monastery of Bursfelde in the Romanesque style. The pretty baroque town of Bad Karlshafen offers you the opportunity to visit the saltwater thermal baths or the Huguenot museum. The small town of Beverungen attracts guests with the remains of a castle from 1330.

Day 3: Beverungen – Holzminden / Bodenwerder, approx. 40 – 55 km

Today you will leave the foothills of the Solling behind you, before reaching the Fürstenberg castle, which is yet another great example of the Weser-Renaissance. It was first built around 1600 as a hunting castle and offers visitors an excellent view of the Weser Valley. Passing through Höxter with its numerous wooden-framed houses, you will reach Bodenwerder, the home of Münchhausen.

Day 4: Holzminden – Hameln, approx. 25 / 55 km

You will get on your bike again and cycle along the river Weser. We recommend a detour to the castle Hämelschenburg, an especially beautiful example of Weser Renaissance architecture. The destination

of your journey, the Pied Piper town Hamelin, is close by. A Pied Piper open-air festival and the Pied Piper House evoke the origin of this famous legend.

On a city tour through the old town you will explore the buildings – some of them might have witnessed the tragic events described in the famous story.

Day 5: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
