


The Tauern Cycle Route

Your tour

Stunning mountain ranges reflected in glittering lakes on one side, sophisticated towns and traditional villages on the other. On the way from the Hohe Tauern to Passau you will experience both. All around you gaze at the high snow-covered peaks of the mountains, while you cycle very relaxed on mostly flat paths through the gentle valleys of the Salzach, Saalach and Inn rivers.

- Return transfer to Krimml: Optionally by transfer bus (daily), departure approx. 14:00, duration approx. 4 hours, must be specified when booking.
- Alternatively on your own by train, connection hourly, duration approx. 7 hours, 3 x changes.
- Twin / double rooms / separate beds are only occasionally available. We treat requests as non-binding customer requests, if above mentioned room types are a booking condition, it must be mentioned as a condition at the time of booking.

Parking in Krimml

→ Public parking near the hotel, about 6 € / day; no reservation possible through Radweg-Reisen.

Luggage transport

→ Luggage pick-up from 09.00 a.m., delivery to the next hotel by 06.00 p.m. at the latest, labeling of luggage is 1 x for the whole tour. No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but max. 20 kg per piece of luggage.

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival to Krimml

Plan an early arrival to Krimml, the first highlight of your bike tour from the Hohe Tauern already awaits you here. On a well-designed high-altitude path you walk to the largest waterfalls in Europe: Over three steps the thundering water masses of the Krimml Waterfalls rush 380 meters into the depths. Do not miss this unique natural spectacle.

Day 2: Krimml – Kaprun / Zell am See, approx. 65 km

Get on your bike right after breakfast. You will cycle leisurely along the Salzach River through the Hohe Tauern National Park. Lush green meadows and small idyllic villages alternate and offer a fairy-tale backdrop with the snow-capped three-thousand-meter peaks in the background. Once in Kaprun, you will visit the castle, the town's landmark, which sits majestically on a hill. Are you still in the mood for a hike? Then go on a voyage of discovery through the Sigmund Thun Gorge (not included).

Day 3: Zell am See – Lofer, approx. 50 km

On today's stage you will cycle through several highlights. Before you start, however, you will first take a refreshing dip in Lake Zell. After a few kilometers you will reach the famous pilgrimage church of Maria Alm. Saalfelden is suitable for your lunch break. Enjoy spicy cheese and sausage from the region to continue cycling invigorated. Explore the Lamprechtshöhle cave near Weißbach on a guided tour (not included) - it is considered one of the longest passage caves in the world.

Day 4: Lofer – Salzburg, approx. 50 km

Today the course of the previously calm river changes. In Unken, the river breaks through the Stone Lake or Steinerne Meer as it is known locally. You continue to reach the spa town of Bad Reichenhall. The river forms a natural border here between Germany and Austria. Cycling through the riverside meadows of the Saalach, you reach the Festival City of Salzburg. Follow the traces of Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart or enjoy the Hohensalzburg castle.

Travel documents

→ 1 set (per booked room) consists of: hotel list and voucher, travel information with details on daily stages, short travel guides and route descriptions, maps, luggage tags

Day 5: Salzburg – Burghausen, approx. 60 km

The Alps are behind you, the diverse Alpine foothills in front of you. You cycle through extensive floodplain forests and the colorful untouched nature of the Lower Inn European Reserve. Numerous species of plants and birds have settled here. Even from a distance you will recognize the seemingly endless battlements and towers of the longest castle complex in the world. Once you arrive in Burghausen, you will first visit the castle and then indulge in the culinary delights of the region in a rustic vaulted cellar.

Day 6: Burghausen – Obernberg am Inn / Bad Füssing, approx. 50 km

Along the Inn River you will comfortably cycle through the quiet, watery nature. Enjoy the wonderful view over the water areas, mud banks and the small wooded islands. Perhaps you will catch a glimpse of a beaver at work. The gothic town of Braunau is suitable for a lunch break. Afterwards, you have a choice - either on the German or Austrian side of the Inn River. Your overnight stop is either the baroque Obernberg or the spa town of Bad Füssing.

Day 7: Obernberg am Inn – Passau, approx. 40 km

Like pearls on a necklace, the numerous towns worth seeing are strung along the Inn River. Visit the Reichersberg Abbey and the baroque market square of Schärding. Now pedal a few more kilometers and you will have reached Passau, the destination of your bike tour. Visit St. Stephan's Cathedral with the largest cathedral organ in the world and stroll through the beautiful old town. From the Veste Oberhaus you can enjoy a magnificent view of the confluence of the Inn, Ilz and Danube rivers. The three different colors of the rivers are unique.

Day 8: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
