Cycle tour in Denmark

Your tour

This cycle tour in Denmark not only takes you to the most important cultural centres of Denmark – Copenhagen and Roskilde. You will also experience the Danish life style and unspoiled nature when you set off on your bike to follow the traces of kings and Vikings through enchanting countryside and following the Öresund river. Explore the Southern part of Sweden, Skåne, as well during a day trip. This cycle tour in Denmark is also suitable for the less practiced cyclist, despite a few hilly sections.

Parking in Kopenhagen

- Hotel parking / garages in Copenhagen, cost approx. 35 – 40 € / day, payable on site.
- No reservation possible through Radweg-Reisen.

Bike handover

- Arrival: Guests' rental bikes will be available at the arrival hotel.
Departure: The guests leave the bikes at the last hotel. If an e-bike has been rented, the battery, charger and key must be returned to the reception.

Luggage transport

- Luggage pick-up from 09.00 a.m., delivery to the next hotel by 06.00 p.m. at the latest, labeling of luggage is 1 x for the whole tour. No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but max. 20 kg per piece of luggage.

Travel documents

- 1 set (per booked room) consists of: hotel list and voucher, travel information with details on daily stages, short travel guides and route descriptions, maps, luggage tags
- Dispatched up to four weeks before arrival. For short-term bookings, delivery to the start hotel, hotel list and arrival information will be sent by email

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival to Copenhagen

Velkommen til København! As one of the oldest capitals in the world, the city impresses with a perfect mix of historical ambience and modern cosmopolitanism. A perfect place to start your bike tour! After checking in at the hotel, grab your bike and explore the city centre. The royal Amalienborg Palace, the nostalgic amusement park Tivoli, the magnificent Rosenborg Slot with the Crown Jewels or the alternative free city Christiania – the earlier you arrive, the better, there is a lot to see!

Day 2: Copenhagen – Helsingør / Snekkersten, approx. 55 / 50 km

The first day of your tour takes you north. From Copenhagen you cycle mostly along the coast from Öresund to Helsingør. Along the way you will pass the famous Bellevue beach, which is simply waiting for you to dive in. In Helsingør you should take the time to visit Castle Kronborg. It was made famous by William Shakespeare's Hamlet and Holger Danske, the hero of a legend, who according to the story wakes up whenever Denmark is in danger to protect it.

Day 3: Excursion to Sweden, approx. 45 km + ferry ride

The ferry trip to Sweden takes about 20 minutes (not included). From Helsingborg you can choose which cycle tour you want to do. The longest takes you to the Kullen peninsula, one of the most beautiful parts of southern Sweden. Rocky cliffs and pleasant bathing areas are the perfect setting for this section. Alternatively you can take the time to explore Helsingør and all its sights.

Day 4: Snekkersten – Hillerød / Slangerup, approx. 30 – 50 km

Today you cycle along the coast, past famous bathing places such as Hornbæk and Gilleleje, which are perfect spots to get off your bike and relax. On the second part of the section, you leave the coast to head into the forests of Gribskov. You cycle to the beautiful Lake Esrom, before you freewheel the last few kilometres down to Hillerød. The landmark of this town is the renaissance castle of Frederiksborg, which stretches over 3 islands in the middle of Lake Frederiksborg.

Day 5: Slangerup – Roskilde, approx. 30 / 40 km

You set off to cycle through the countryside to Roskilde Fjord. There are some lovely places on the way to stop and admire the views. Fields, forests and beautiful beaches line the route to Süden. Today's destination, Roskilde, is where one of Europe's most important music festivals is held. And in Roskilde's cathedral, a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1995, are the graves of 20 Danish kings.

Day 6: Roskilde – Copenhagen, approx. 45 km

Today you cycle back to Copenhagen at a leisurely pace. Treat yourself to a walk through the picturesque harbour district with its colourful houses at the end of your bike tour on Sealand. The most famous sight and at the same time landmark of the city is the Little Mermaid. The bronze figure has been sitting on a granite rock at the Old Harbour for more than 100 years. Or how about an extensive canal and harbour tour?

Day 7: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
