## Journey to Lübeck

- Closest airports: Hamburg
- Train station: Lübeck Hauptbahnhof (main station)

## Parking in Lübeck

- Public car parks, cost approx. 10 EUR / day
- Hotel parking spaces (available in individual hotels, chargeable, details in the travel documents).

## Bike handover

- Arrival: Guests' rental bikes will be available at the arrival hotel.  
Departure: The guests leave the bikes at the last hotel. If an e-bike has been rented, the battery, charger and key must be returned to the reception.

### Luggage transport

→ Luggage pick-up from 09.00 a.m., delivery to the next hotel by 06.00 p.m. at the latest, labeling of luggage is 1 x for the whole tour. No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but max. 20 kg per piece of luggage.

### Travel documents

→ 1 set (per booked room) consists of: hotel list and voucher, travel information with details on daily stages, short travel guides and route descriptions, maps, luggage tags

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### Stages description

#### Day 1: Individual arrival in Lübeck

Your bike tour starts in the old, magnificent Hanseatic city, which was named a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1987. If you talk about Holstentor, marzipan and Thomas Mann, Lübeck immediately comes to mind. You should not miss a fish roll as a prelude to your vacation.

#### Day 2: Lübeck – Wismar, ca. 55 km + boat and ferry trip

You start the day with a boat trip on the Trave to Travemünde, where you can make a stop at Germany's oldest lighthouse before taking the ferry to Priwall (not included) and cycling along the Baltic Sea coast through the Brooker Wald nature reserve to Boltenhagen on the first stage. From the cliffs, you can look out over the entire bay. You then continue to the enchanting Hanseatic town of Wismar.

#### Day 3: Wismar – Bad Doberan, approx. 60 km + boat trip

Today starts with a boat trip to the island of Poel. Get your swimming gear ready - the island has beautiful beaches! If you want to include a tour of the island, expect to cover an extra 25 kilometres. Then cycle via the Baltic seaside resorts of Rerik and Kühlungsborn to the tranquil cathedral town of Bad Doberan.

#### Day 4: Bad Doberan – Dierhagen / Graal-Müritz, approx. 50 / 45 km + ferry ride

Before you get to know the Fischland peninsula today, you can visit the widest beach on the German Baltic coast in Warnemünde. Or how about a detour to the Hanseatic city of Rostock? In Warnemünde,

take the ferry to Hohe Düne (not included) and reach the leisurely Ribnitz-Damgarten, situated on the Saale Bodden with its amber museum, or the seaside resort of Graal-Müritz.

#### Day 5: Dierhagen – Barth / Zingst, approx. 45 – 60 km

Discover the "Darßer Wald" (Darss woods) and the romantic of the wild west beach, which is considered to be one of the most beautiful beaches in Europe. From Prerow it can only be reached by foot, by bike or by horse-drawn carriage. Via Zingst, you cycle back to the mainland, to the former Swedish town of Barth.

#### Day 6: Barth – Stralsund, approx. 45 / 55 km

Look forward to the last section of your tour: the three towers of the Hanseatic town of Stralsund beckon from afar. Its former importance as a trading town can still be seen today. Let your evening come to a pleasant end in the old town, which has been declared a UNESCO World Heritage site because it has been so beautifully preserved.

#### Day 7: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
