## Your tour

Discover on this bike tour the North Sea shore and the Lower Elbe between Husum – the hometown of Theodor Storm – and the Elbe metro-pole Hamburg in a very relaxed way. Observe the rapid sand yachts at the 12-kilometer-long Beach of St. Peter-Ording, walk along the canals of the “Dutch city” Friedrichstadt, experience in Brunsbüttel, how ocean giants pass the Kiel-Canal and try the traditionally produced maatjes in Glückstadt. Let’s go to the North!

### Return journey to Husum

- On your own by train from Hamburg, connections hourly, duration: approx. 2,5 hours, 1x change trains

### Bike handover

- Arrival: The rental bikes are waiting at the start hotel.
- Departure: The bikes are left at the last hotel. Provided an e-bike has been rented, the battery should be handed in at reception.

### Luggage transport

- Daily baggage collection until 9 a.m.
- Delivery to the next hotel by 6 p.m. at the latest
- Luggage items are labeled once for the entire tour
- No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but a maximum of 20 kg per piece of luggage

### Travel documents

- Dispatched to the tour operator up to six weeks before arrival

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### Stages description

#### Day 1: Individual arrival in Husum

The small town of Husum is shaped by the interplay of the tides. The North Sea reaches right into the inland harbour. Observe the ebb and flow of the tide in the middle of the town. Stroll through the narrow streets and alleys and marvel at the picturesque, differently coloured gabled houses.

#### Day 2: Husum – Friedrichstadt – Tönning / Lunden, approx. 35 / 40 km

Having left Husum behind, you cycle inland. You reach Friedrichstadt. Once in the town centre, you will immediately feel transported to the Netherlands. The Dutch immigrants who settled here in the 17th century brought their architectural style with them and so Friedrichstadt developed into a Dutch town including canals and gabled houses. The tour continues to Tönning. There, it is worth visiting the Multimar Wattforum, which introduces you to the world of the Wadden Sea. You will spend the night in Tönning or Lunden.

#### Day 3: Excursion to St. Peter-Ording, approx. 35 / 55 km + train ride

Your bike tour today takes you to one of Germany's most famous beaches. The train (included) takes you to St. Peter-Ording. The beach there impresses with a length of 12 kilometres and is ideal for watching kite surfers being pulled over the waves by the wind. Or how about a mudflat hike? Alternatively, just spend your time in St. Peter-Ording leisurely sunbathing before cycling back to Tönning or Lunden.

#### Day 4: Tönning – Büsum – St. Michaelisdonn, approx. 60 / 70 km

On today's stage, you leave Tönning heading west and first reach the Eider barrage, Germany's largest coastal protection structure. With the North Sea in view, you cycle on in a relaxed manner to Büsum. The small seaside resort is particularly famous for its Büsum crabs. Take a short break on the kilometre-long green beach and treat yourself to a crab roll - perfect! On the way to your destination for the day, St. Michaelisdonn, you will get to know the charming landscape of Dithmarschen.

#### Day 5: St. Michaelisdonn – Glückstadt, approx. 45 km

Leaving St. Michaelisdonn and the Dithmarschen region behind you, you will meet the Elbe and the Kiel Canal at Brunsbüttel. The canal has been in operation since 1895 and is one of the busiest waterways in the world. Watch small and large ships pass through the impressive canal locks before you head for Glückstadt along the Elbe. Here, too, a North German delicacy awaits you, the Glückstädter Matjes. It is famous beyond the region and is made by hand according to old recipes.

#### Day 6: Glückstadt – Hamburg, approx. 55 km

The last stage takes you along the Elbe. On the way you have an excellent view of the many large ships gliding gently over the water. A stop-over is worthwhile in Wedel. The ship welcoming system there musically greets and bids farewell to ships arriving or departing from the Port of Hamburg. Hamburg is the crowning glory of your journey. The Hanseatic city awaits you with numerous sights such as the Elbe Philharmonic Hall, the fish market and the Speicherstadt.

#### Day 7: Individual departure or extension of stay

After breakfast, your individual journey home or an extension of your stay.
