Your tour

The journey takes you to and off the North Sea coast of Schleswig-Holstein, to its Hallig islands and islets. You will get to know the Hallig Hooe and Langeneß. get to know. In addition, you can take an excursion to the island of Sylt, Föhr or the island of Amrum – just as you like. Another highlight of this trip is an excursion to the seaside resort of St. Peter-Ording. It is known nationwide for its kilometre-long beach, its unique pile dwellings and the numerous kite and windsurfers. Despite the fact that you will be cycling almost without any ascents, you can expect some strong winds, which can make cycling difficult at times.

- Closest airports: Hamburg, Billund
- Train station: Husum

Parking in Husum

- Harbour car park: Am Binnenhafen, 470 parking spaces, unlimited, costs approx. 8 euros / day.
- Hotel parking spaces (available in individual hotels, chargeable, details in the travel documents).

Bike handover

- Arrival: Guests' rental bikes will be available at the arrival hotel.
Departure: The guests leave the bikes at the last hotel. If an e-bike has been rented, the battery, charger and key must be returned to the reception.

Luggage transport

- Luggage pick-up from 09.00 a.m., delivery to the next hotel by 06.00 p.m. at the latest, labeling of luggage is 1 x for the whole tour. No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but max. 20 kg per piece of luggage.

Travel documents

- 1 set (per booked room) consists of: hotel list and voucher, travel information with details on daily stages, short travel guides and route descriptions, maps, luggage tags

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Husum

The small town of Husum is shaped by the interplay of the tides. The North Sea reaches right into the inland harbour. Observe the ebb and flow of the tide in the middle of the town. Stroll through the narrow streets and alleys and marvel at the picturesque, differently coloured gabled houses.

Day 2: Excursion to St. Peter-Ording, approx. 60 km + train ride

Today we travel by train to St. Peter-Ording. The seaside resort is known for its 12-kilometre-long sandy beach, which is ideal for extensive sunbathing or various water sports. On the way back to Husum, you can cycle to the Westerhever lighthouse, which is visible from afar. It is the landmark of the Eiderstedt peninsula.

Day 3: Excursion to the island of Sylt + train rides

A train will take you from Husum to the island of Sylt via Niebüll. The largest North Frisian island is extremely scenic and impresses with its kilometre-long sandy beaches, cliffs, dune areas and thatched houses. The island boasts a network of over 200 kilometres of cycle paths. Ideal for a short or long cycling tour. Cycle along the former Sylt island railway line, to the Hörnum lighthouse, to the Red Cliff near Kampen, or have a fish sandwich in List, the options you can choose from are nearly endless. In the evening you return to Husum by train.

Day 4: Husum – Hooge island – Schlüttsiel / Dagebüll, ca. 35 / 45 km + boat trips

Today's stage starts early in the morning with the bike tour to the peninsula Nordstrand. With the ferry (included) you will cross over to the Hallig Hooge at approximately 9:15 a.m.. The Hallig is the second largest of this type of island in the North Frisian Wadden Sea. In the afternoon you will take the ferry to Schlüttsiel, back to the mainland.

Day 5: Excursion to Hallig Langeneß

Today we take the ferry (not included) to the largest of the ten North Frisian Hallig islands - Langeneß. Explore the narrow and elongated Hallig in a relaxed way by bike. Visit the Captain Tadsen Museum and the Friesenstube. Or how about a detour to the lighthouse at the western tip? Take the ferry back to Schlüttsiel.

Day 6: Excursion to the island of Föhr or the island of Amrum, approx. 15 km

On today's excursion day of your cycle tour across the Halligen you are spoilt for choice. You can choose to visit the island of Föhr or the island of Amrum. First you cycle to Dagebüll. From there you can reach the respective island comfortably by ferry (not included). With Föhr you get to know the green island. Thanks to its protected location, it has particularly lush vegetation. Explore the island by bike or enjoy the sound of the North Sea on the southern beach. On Amrum you can also enjoy a kilometre-long sandy beach, the so-called Kniepsand. Or how about a guided mudflat hike? In the evening you return to Dagebüll by ferry (not included).

Day 7: Schlüttsiel – Husum, approx. 45 km

You cycle directly along the coast. On the way, make a detour to the Hamburger Hallig. The small peninsula is very easy to reach by bike. At the end of the Hallig, an inn invites you to a longer and more scenic stay. In your destination for the day, Husum, the town's most famous son, Theodor Storm, is commemorated at every turn. The writer once described Husum as a gray town by the sea. Far from it, because the colorful and lively harbor town is neither gray nor drab.

Day 8: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
