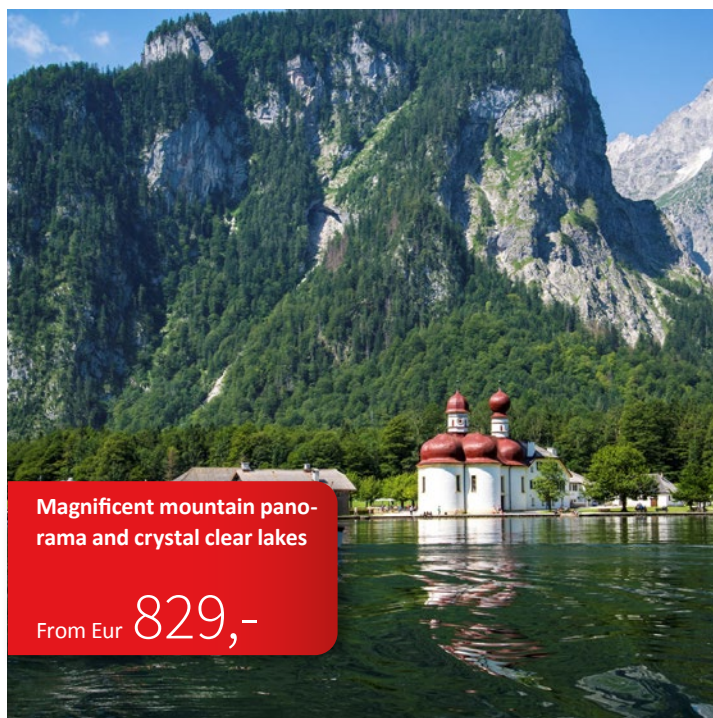


Cycling tour from Lake Chiemsee to Lake Königssee

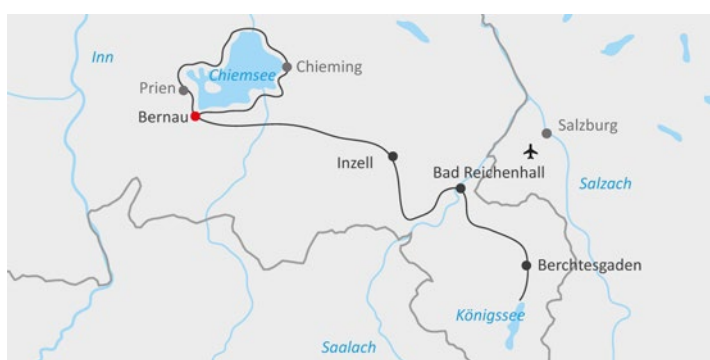

Your tour

Follow in the footsteps of King Ludwig II on your bike tour to Königssee. The journey begins at the beautiful Chiemsee, whose deep blue waters are surrounded by dreamlike nature and towering mountains. Cycle along the idyllic shore and through picturesque little villages. Explore Herreninsel, with the castle of the fairytale king, and the monastery on Fraueninsel. With the beautiful backdrop of the foothills of the Alps always in view, you roll leisurely through a paradisiacal spot on your way to Königssee. Lush green meadows and shady forests are your constant companions. Visit idyllic towns like Inzell and Bad Reichenhall with their numerous sights. Seemingly within reach of the Alps is the Königssee lake.

- Return journey to Chiemsee: Optionally by minibus including bike every Saturday morning, must be specified when booking, payable in advance.
- Alternatively on your own by train, connections every hour, 1 change, duration approx. 1.5 hours.
- Twin / double rooms / separate beds are only occasionally available. We treat requests as non-binding customer requests, if above mentioned room types are a booking condition, it must be mentioned as a condition at the time of booking.

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival at Bernau or Prien

After your journey to Lake Chiemsee, you have the opportunity to take in the beautiful scenery on a walk along the shore. Before you get more information about your cycle tour from Chiemsee to Königssee in the evening, treat yourself to a hearty snack in a traditional pub.

Day 2: Excursion around Lake Chiemsee, approx. 65 km

On the saddle, get set, go! Once around Lake Chiemsee - that's how your cycle tour begins. On this circular tour, you will discover everything that Bavaria's largest lake has to offer. Lively lakeside towns and picturesque little villages lie along the way. You will find numerous secluded bays for a break. As you cycle leisurely along the shore, there are always marvellous views of the surrounding mountains. How about a refreshment stop in a shady beer garden?

Day 3: Stay at Lake Chiemsee

After you have already discovered Lake Chiemsee by bike, you can organise another day to suit your mood. Experience the history and stories of Bavaria's largest lake in the numerous museums in Prien or Seebuck. Take the boat to Herreninsel. There you will find King Ludwig II's magnificent castle, which is well worth a visit. The Fraueninsel is quite different. The small houses are densely packed together and full of nooks and crannies. Immerse yourself in the lively island life.

Day 4: Chiemsee – Inzell, approx. 30 / 45 km

Cycling around the Hochfelln, the local Chiemgau mountain, you will continue on along flat paths to Adelholzen, which is one of the oldest baths with healing waters in Bavaria. The Museum of Natural History

and Mammoth Museum is located in Siegsdorf. The tour then leads you along the Roten Traun to the former mining village of Inzell which is now a spa town renowned for its clean, fresh air.

Day 5: Inzell – Bad Reichenhall, approx. 30 km

High mountains to the right and left, with the German Alpine Road in the middle, on which you cycle today. Your destination is the spa town of Bad Reichenhall. After this short stage, treat yourself to a wellness day at the thermal spa (not included). You have a wonderful view of the fascinating mountain world through the large glass fronts. The mountain is calling! Take the oldest cable car in the world up the Predigtstuhl. At 1614 metres above sea level, you can enjoy the unique panorama of the surrounding peaks.

Day 6: Bad Reichenhall – Berchtesgaden / Königssee, approx. 20 / 30 km

Typical Bavarian villages and lush green meadows accompany you on the last stage of your cycle tour from Chiemsee to Königssee through the idyllic foothills of the Alps. You will soon reach the Königssee, which is narrow and elongated between steep, towering rock faces. From the shore, you can only see a small part of the fjord-like lake. It's worth taking a trip on the silent electric boats to the pilgrimage church of Bartholomä, which is located on a peninsula

Day 7: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
