Your Tour

Experience a truly enjoyable cycling holiday around the Upper Lake, the biggest part of Lake Constance. The cycling stages are quite short, so you have more than enough time to visit all the sights along the way. Which are many! You visit every must-see around Lake Constance: The "Flower Island" of Mainau, the lake dwelling settlements in Uhldingen, the Zeppelin museum in Friedrichshafen and last but not least the mountain top of Pfänder Mountain, high above Bregenz.

Child reduction on basic price

- → Reductions apply for accommodation in rooms with two full-paying guests.

Parking in Constance

- → Free parking on public roads
- → Fenced parking lot near the Radweg-Reisen office in Constance, cost: 45 Euro, must be booked and paid in advance.
- → Parking garages (Fischmarkt, Dammgasse, Lago, Altstadt, Benediktinerplatz), costs approx. 10 20 Euro / day
- → Hotel parking spaces (available in individual hotels, chargeable, details in the travel documents).

Journey to Constance

- → Closest airport: Zürich, Friedrichshafen, Stuttgart
- → Train station: Constance

Twin rooms / separate beds

- → Available only sporadically

- → In case twin rooms are booking condition it must be clearly communicated as such when booking.

Availability

- → All bookings are on request

Travel documents

- → Dispatched to the tour operator up to six weeks before departure
- → For short-term bookings, delivery to the start hotel, hotel list and arrival information will be sent by email
- → 1 set (per booked room) consists of: hotel list and voucher, travel information with details on daily stages, short travel guides and route descriptions, maps, luggage tags

Bike handover

- → Arrival: Guests' rental bikes will be available on the company premises at the rental bike counter.
- → Departure: The guests leave their bikes in the last hotel. Provided an e-bike has been rented, the battery should be handed in at reception

Luggage transport

- → Daily baggage collection until 9 a.m.
- → Delivery to the next hotel by 6 p.m. at the latest
- → Luggage items are labeled once for the entire tour
- → No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but a maximum of 20 kg per piece of luggage

Stage description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Constance

Your trip starts in Constance, the largest city in the area. Worth a visit are the well preserved historic old town, the aquariums in the Sea Life Center, the statue "Imperia" at the harbour and of course the Minster with its tall church tower. If you want to warm up your legs just climb the stairs to the top of the Minster tower and enjoy the view of Constance and Lake Constance.

Day 2: Day trip to Mainau Island, approx. 15 km

First you explore the "flower island" of Mainau. Bikes are not allowed on the island: simply park at the entrance and access the island via the bridge. Countless flowers bloom here - tulips in spring, roses in summer and dahlias in the autumn. But the castle, the palm garden, the butterfly house, the Arboretum and many other attractions are waiting to be explored.

Day 3: Constance – Meersburg – Uhldingen – Friedrichshafen, approx. 30 km + Ferry

The ferry takes you across Lake Constance to Meersburg. You can either take a stroll through the medieval town of Meersburg, visit one of the two or both castels or hop on your bike and visit the town in the afternoon on your way back. By bike you go to Uhldingen and visit the lake dwelling settlements. You learn how people lived in the area a very long time ago: Not at but above the lake! After the visit you cycle back the known route to Meersburg and onwards through Immenstaad to Friedrichshafen.

Day 4: Friedrichshafen – Lindau / Bregenz, approx. 40 / 50 km

If you didn't make it yesterday you can take your time for the Zeppelin museum today. The history of the famous air ships is presented in a very lively and interesting way. A highlight not only for fans of air travel. Next, you cycle through extensive orchards, through Langenargen with its pretty Montfort Castle, built in the Moorish style. Shortly after you reach the Bavarian town of Lindau, whose harbour is watched over by a 6-metre high lion. If you spend the night in Lindau you reached your destination, if your hotel is located in Bregenz you just cycle on for about 10 km along the Lake and cross the border to Austria. Bregenz is not only the capital of the Vorarlberg region of Austria, but also famous for its annual festival on the largest lake-stage in the world.

Day 5: Bregenz - Rorschach / Arbon, approx. 40 / 50 km

In the morning the Pfänder cable car lifts you smoothly up to the mountain top 1022 m above sea level. You enjoy a famous view: Not only above Lake Constance but also into the mountain tops of the Alps. Back on the ground you cycle through the Rhine Delta. At the border between Austria and Switzerland the Alpine Rhine flows into Lake Constance. In the Swiss town of Altenrhein you should have a look at the market hall of the famous, colourful artist Hundertwasser. Afterwards you cycle through Rorschach to Arbon.

Day 6: Arbon - Konstanz, approx. 35 km

The last stage leads you through Romanshorn with the biggest harbour of the Swiss Lake Constance shore. Alongside the Lake you take on the cycling back to Constance. This stretch is flat and easy to cycle, unless in a stronger westerly wind. You will frequently pass places where you can go swimming and refresh yourself in the lovely cool waters of the lake. Back in Constance you should treat yourself to an ice cream at the harbour and just enjoy your last night at the beautiful Lake Constance.

Day 7: Individual departure or extension of stay

After breakfast, you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
