#### Bike handover

- → Arrival: The rental bikes are waiting at the start hotel.
- → Departure: The guests leave their bikes in the last hotel. Provided an e-bike has been rented, the battery should be handed in at reception.

### Luggage transport

- → Daily baggage collection until 9 a.m.
- → Delivery to the next hotel by 6 p.m. at the latest
- → Luggage items are labeled once for the entire tour
- → No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but a maximum of 20 kg per piece of luggage

→ On your own by train from Aarhus: Connections several times daily, 1x change. Duration approx. 3 hours.

# **Stage Description**

### Day 1: Individual arrival in Flensburg

Flensburg is located north of Germany and therefore is an ideal starting point for a bike tour on the Baltic Sea Cycle Route. Take a walk through the beautiful streets and corners of the old town with the typical merchants' courtyards in Flensburg.

# Day 2: Flensburg - Sønderborg, approx. 45 km

Today you first cycle along the Flensburg Fjord. On the way it is worth stopping for a visit at the summer residence of the Danish royal family in Gråsten. Sønderborg, your first destination, is on the island of Als. Visit the Sønderborg Slot. The castle of the 12th century now houses a museum.

#### Day 3: Sønderborg – Åbenrå, approx. 35 km

Today awaits a relaxed day of cycling on the Sundewitt peninsula through forests and over wide fields. A visit to Sandbjerg Castle, one of the most elegant palaces in the South of Jutland, is worth it. Åbenrå impresses with its charming town and craft houses.

### Day 4: Åbenrå – Christiansfeld, approx. 50 – 70 km

To the north, the impressive Vor Frue Cathedral can already be seen from afar. The Haderslever Dom is one of the most beautiful places of worship in Denmark. Take a boat tour on the Haderslever Dam whilst you are there. The city of Christiansfeld only originated 250 years ago.

# Day 5: Christiansfeld - Middelfart, approx. 50 - 65 km

You decide whether you want to go directly to Middelfahrt or cycle along the Little Belt. Make a stop in Kolding and visit the Koldinghus. Enjoy the great view over the whole city and the Kolding Fjord from the tower of the castle, the Kæmpetårn.

# Day 6: Middelfart – Vejle, approx. 50 km

The city of Fredericia lies on the other side of Middelfart and can be reached by crossing the Little Belt. Worth seeing is the center of the city, which was created in a checkerboard pattern. Once in Veijle a visit to the windmill, the symbol of the city, is worthwhile. Inside it contains a museum about the history of the mill.

# Day 7: Vejle – Horsens, approx. 45 km

Today's cycle route inland is partly hilly and surrounded by forests. A former state prison can be visited in Horsens. Vitus Bering is the celebrity of this town. In the 18th century he saild through the Bering Strait, named after him, between America and Asia. Even the city park in Horsens commemorates him.

# Day 8: Horsens – Norsminde / Odder, approx. 55 km

Today you continue north. After countless glances at the glittering Baltic Sea and with one or the other fresh sea breeze you reach your overnight accommodation in Norsminde or Odder. How about an evening stroll through the city?

# Day 9: Norsminde / Odder - Aarhus, approx. 20 / 30 km

Today's bike route is short on purpose. Like this you can enjoy Aarhus, the second largest City of Denmark, a bit longer. On the way there you find numerous opportunities for a longer break on the beach.

### Day 10: Individual departure or extension of stay

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or we extend your stay.
