How many islands are there in the South Fyn Archipelago? It is impossible to count them. You visit at least five of them: Fyn, of course, the largest island, but also Als, Ærø, Drejø and Skarø. Around the Little Belt you will spend a wonderful time on your bike and have enough time to visit the most beautiful castles on the fairy tale island, as Funen is also called.

Parking in Flensburg

Bike handover

- Arrival: The rental bikes are waiting at the start hotel.
- Departure: The guests leave their bikes in the last hotel. Provided an e-bike has been rented, the battery should be handed in at reception.

Luggage transport

- Daily baggage collection until 9 a.m.
- Delivery to the next hotel by 6 p.m. at the latest
- Luggage items are labeled once for the entire tour
- No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but a maximum of 20 kg per piece of luggage

Stage Description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Flensburg

Flensburg is located in the North of Germany and therefore an ideal starting point for a bike tour on the Baltic Sea Cycle Route. After your arrival, stroll through the beautiful alleys and nooks of the old town with its typical merchant courtyards.

Day 2: Flensburg – Åbenrå, approx. 55 km

You leave Flensburg behind and cross the border to Denmark after a short time. On the Ox Trail, where cattle used to be driven to the markets, you cycle along quiet paths to Åbenrå.

Day 3: Åbenrå – Christiansfeld, approx. 40 – 65 km

Today you cycle first to Haderslev. The medieval old town at Haderslev Dam attracts with numerous cafés and a walk along the reservoir, which dates back to the Middle Ages. Back on the saddle, you roll comfortably through the quiet area to Christiansfeld.

Day 4: Christiansfeld – Middelfart, approx. 50 km

After leaving Christiansfeld you cycle through the wooded region to Kolding. From far away you can already see the mighty tower of the old royal castle Koldinghus. Passing the Kolding Fjord and via Skærbæk you cross the Little Belt, just before you reach your destination for today, Middelfart.

Day 5: Round trip around Middelfart, approx. 45 km

Explore the north of Fyn today. In the middle of the nature park Lillebælt you cycle through quiet landscapes. The lively small town of Middelfart offers numerous restaurants and has a harbour worth seeing.

Day 6: Middelfart – Assens / Ebberup, approx. 40 / 55 km

You cycle along the west coast of the island of Funen, along the Little Belt. This landscape will simply inspire you. The island is also known as Denmark's garden. In the restaurants along the way you will be spoiled with local specialties.

Day 7: Assens / Ebberup – Fåborg, approx. 30 – 50 km

Alternating between wooded areas and small villages, you will head south today. From a beautiful vantage point on a hill near Haastrup you can look out over the island to the sea. A visit to the bell tower, the landmark of the town of Fåborg, is worthwhile in any case.

Day 8: Fåborg– Ærø Island – Svendborg, approx. 25 – 50 km + boat trips

Your today's stage starts with a boat trip to the island Ærø. The hygge island will inspire you. You must not miss to try the airy pancakes, a specialty of the island, before you leave this place again.

Day 9: Excursion to the islands Drejø and Skarø, approx. 20 km + boat trips

First you again go by boat to the island of Drejø, where only very few people live. Afterwards you cross over to the next less crowded island - Skarø. Enjoy the idyllic peace and quiet today.

Day 10: Svendborg – Sønderborg, approx. 60 km + boat trip

You leave Svendborg behind and cycle through the south of the island of Funen. In Bøjden you board the ferry and ride to Fynshav on the island of Als. Back on the bike you cycle across the island, which also has one or two hills to overcome.

Day 11: Sønderborg – Flensburg, approx. 45 km

Visit the castle of the same name in Sønderborg, one of the oldest royal castles in Jutland, right on the water. Afterwards you start your last stage of your bike tour. A break is worthwhile in Gråsten, where the summer residence of the Danish royal family is located. Soon you cross the border and be back in Flensburg.

Day 12: Individual departure or extension of stay

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or we extend your stay.
