

Cycle tour along the Lillebælt

Your Tour

The tour takes you around the Little Belt. With about 75 kilometres per stage, you cycle quickly and almost without ascents along the Flensburg Fjord, the Baltic Sea coast of southern Jutland and the islands of Funen, \mathcal{E} rø and Als. A wide variety of landscapes with lush forests, picturesque coastlines, small fishing villages and historic towns await you on this trip. At Middelfart, with a bit of luck, you can watch porpoises cavorting in the water, and on the island of \mathcal{E} rø, the bathing houses on the beach can be seen from afar. In between, there is always time for a dip in the clear water.

Bike handover

- → Arrival: The rental bikes are waiting at the start hotel.
- → Departure: The guests leave their bikes in the last hotel. Provided an e-bike has been rented, the battery should be handed in at reception.

Luggage transport

- → Daily baggage collection until 9 a.m.
- → Delivery to the next hotel by 6 p.m. at the latest
- → Luggage items are labeled once for the entire tour
- → No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but a maximum of 20 kg per piece of luggage

Stage description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Flensburg

You start your journey in Flensburg, one of the northernmost cities in Germany. There is much to discover in the well-preserved old town - for example historic medieval buildings, beautiful courtyards or the Nordertor, the town's landmark.

Day 2: Flensburg - Sønderborg - Åbenrå, approx. 80 km

Near Flensburg you cross the German-Danish border. In Gråsten it is worth taking a first break to see the summer residence of the Danish royal family. Via Sønderborg you continue to Nydam Mose, a bog that was used as a sacrificial site in the Iron Age. In Åbenrå, the old town with its typical burghers' and craftsmen's houses is worth a visit.

Day 3: Åbenrå – Kolding, approx. 95 km

Today you first drive to Haderslev. The old town, situated on a peninsula, is dominated by the Vor Frue Domkirke - one of the most beautiful Gothic churches in Denmark. In Kolding, your destination for the day, you will notice the Koldinghus - a castle-like palace that looks back on a long history and houses a museum today. From the tower of the castle, you have a wide view of the city and the Kolding Fjord.

Day 4: Kolding - Middelfart - Ebberup, approx. 70 - 80 km

Today you cross the Lillebæltsbroen - a bridge that connects Jutland with Funen. Arriving in the Funen harbour town of Middelfart, you can admire one of Denmark's most beautiful half-timbered houses near the harbour, the Henner Friisers Hus. It also houses a museum that shows the history of whaling in the Little Belt. From Middelfart you follow the west coast of Funen and reach Ebberup.

Day 5: Ebberup - Fåborg - Svendborg, approx. 65 - 75km

You start the day with a round trip over the Helnæs peninsula. A refreshing swim is worthwhile at Helnæsstrand. In Faaborg you can enjoy the view of the surroundings and the sea from the town's landmark, the bell tower. Once in Svendborg, there is time for a walk to admire the many half-timbered houses that give the town its flair.

Day 6: Svendborg - Ærø Island - Fåborg, approx. 60 km + boat trip

Take the ferry to Ærøskøbing on the island of Ærø. The town has an old town that is well worth seeing. On a tour around the island, you get to know the harbour town of Marstal. In the Søfartsmuseum you will learn how the town once became Denmark's most important harbour town. On your way to the ferry port in Søby, you see the Skjoldnæs lighthouse. It has the highest beacon in the region. From Søby, you take the ferry to your destination for the day, Fåborg.

Day 7: Fåborg – Sønderborg – Flensburg, approx. 70 km + boat trip

Start your day with a short ride across the Horne Land peninsula. In Bøjden you take the ferry and reach the island of Als in Fynshav. In Sønderborg, we recommend a visit to Sønderborg Slot and in Dybbol the Düppeler Schanzen are well worth a visit. Along the Flensburg Fjord you return to Flensburg.

Day 8: Individual departure or extension of stay

Your journey ends after breakfast. We are happy to extend your stay in Flensburg with an extra night.
