# Your Tour

On this round trip from Flensburg, the focus is on cycling. You pass the German-Danish border on your bike and discover the most beautiful spots in southern Denmark, kilometre by kilometre. From the mild Baltic Sea you reach the rough North Sea with detours to the Wadden Sea islands of Fanø, Mandø, Rømø and Sylt. Back on the mainland, you'll get to know the enchanting towns of Møgeltønder and Tønder.

#### **Bike handover**

- → Arrival: The rental bikes are waiting at the start hotel.
- → Departure: The guests leave their bikes in the last hotel. Provided an e-bike has been rented, the battery should be handed in at reception.

# Luggage transport

- → Daily baggage collection until 9 a.m.
- $\rightarrow$  Delivery to the next hotel by 6 p.m. at the latest
- $\rightarrow$  Luggage items are labeled once for the entire tour
- → No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but a maximum of 20 kg per piece of luggage

#### Stage description

#### Day 1: Individual arrival in Flensburg

The port city of Flensburg, located to the north, is a good starting point for a bike tour. The history of the city is more than 750 years old. The trading town offers some interesting sights and we therefore recommend an early arrival.

### Day 2: Flensburg – Sønderborg – Åbenrå, approx. 80 km

First you have to cross the German-Danish border. Visit Gråsten Castle - the summer residence of the Danish royal family. You should also pay a visit to Sønderborg Slot, to learn more about the history of the region. Your first destination for the day is the old town of Åbenrå.

#### Day 3: Åbenrå – Haderslev – Kolding, approx. 80 km

Today we first go to the peninsula of Haderslev. The church there, Frue Domkirke, is considered the most beautiful church of Denmark. Kolding, your today's destination cannot be overlooked. From the tower of the Kæmpetårn you can look over the whole town to the Kolding Fjord.

#### Day 4: Kolding – Esbjerg, approx. 80 km

Heading west and through flat terrain, you will travel from Kolding to Esbjerg. Established only 150 years ago, Esbjerg is one of the most important harbour towns in Denmark. From the 33 meter high water tower you have a great view over the city, the harbour and as far as the island of Fanø.

### Day 5: Esbjerg – Fanø – Ribe, approx. 70 – 80 km + boat trip

A ferry (not included) will take you to the island of Fanø. Today you decide whether you want to explore the island by bike or whether you would rather enjoy a relaxing sunbath on the fine sandy beaches of the west coast. Later, the ferry will take you back to the mainland. Ribe, the oldest city of Denmark with its unequal towers, can be seen from afar.

#### Day 6: Ribe - Mandø - Havneby (Island of Rømø), approx. 70 km

Today you go to the island of Mandø. At low tide a tractor bus (not included) takes you to the tidal island. The largest sandbank in the Wadden Sea, Koresand, in the southwest of the island, is particularly impressive. You may be lucky enough to see seals sunbathing. Continue on to the island of Rømø. The main town Havneby is your destination today.

# Day 7: Havneby – Sylt – Niebüll, approx. 65 – 75 km + train and boat trip

After a short crossing you reach List on the island of Sylt - Germany's northernmost community. At the harbour you will be tempted by the smell of fish rolls. After a small refreshment you can explore the island on any of the bike routes. The train from Westerland brings you back to the mainland.

#### Day 8: Niebüll – Tønder – Flensburg, approx. 70 – 90 km

On your last cycling stage, a visit to Møgeltønder is worthwhile. The neighbouring town of Tønder once became famous for its lace-making craft. You then cycle along the border back to Flensburg.

#### Day 9: Individual departure or extension of stay

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or we extend your stay.
