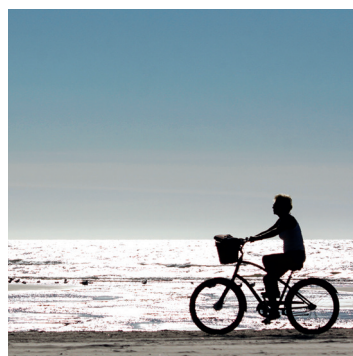

## Bike handover

- Arrival: The rental bikes are waiting at the start hotel.
- Departure: The guests leave their bikes in the last hotel. Provided an e-bike has been rented, the battery should be handed in at reception.

## Luggage transport

- Daily baggage collection until 9 a.m.
- Delivery to the next hotel by 6 p.m. at the latest
- Luggage items are labeled once for the entire tour
- No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but a maximum of 20 kg per piece of luggage

## Return journey to Hamburg

- On your own by train from Esbjerg: Connections several times a day, 1 x change. Duration approx. 3.5 hours.

## Stage description

### Day 1: Individual arrival in Hamburg

In the Hanseatic city of Hamburg you can see and discover a lot. Therefore we recommend an early arrival. You will have a particularly good view of the hustle and bustle of the city from the city's landmark – the tower of St. Michael's.

### Day 2: Hamburg – Glückstadt, approx. 55 km

Your first stage along the Elbe River takes you to Wedel. Wedel has a special ship welcoming facility that greets or bids farewell to large ships arriving or departing the Port of Hamburg with flags hoisted and lowered. Your stage destination is Glückstadt with its specialty – the Glückstädter Matjes (pickled herring).

### Day 3: Glückstadt – St. Michaelisdonn, approx. 55 km

In Brunsbüttel you can visit the most frequented artificial waterway in the world – the Kiel Canal. For deeper insights into the history, a visit to the lock museum is recommended. The Dutchman's mill Edda in St. Michaelisdonn is the landmark of the place.

### Day 4: St. Michaelisdonn – Tönning, approx. 65 km

Today you cycle to the sea. Take a break at the kilometer-long green beach in Büsum and enjoy the speciality of this town – Büsumer Krabbenbrötchen (prawn sandwiches). Having arrived in Tönning we recommend a visit to the Multimar Wattforum. Here you get information about life in the Wadden Sea.

### Day 5: Tönning – Husum, approx. 60 km + train ride

Initially you take the train to St. Peter Ording. On the 12-kilometer-long sandy beach, striking pile dwellings have stood for over 100 years and still serve the physical well-being of beachgoers. Your destination Husum commemorates everywhere the famous son of the city, Theodor Storm.

### Day 6: Husum – Niebüll, approx. 55 km

Along the coast you can make a detour to the Hamburger Hallig. The small peninsula is easy to reach by bike. Strengthened, you cycle on to Niebüll via the Schlüttsiel ferry port and Dagebüll.

### Day 7: Niebüll – Sylt Island – Havneby (Rømø Island), approx. 35 km + train and ferry ride

In the morning you take the train to the island of Sylt via the Hindenburgdamm. The island offers a 200 kilometer long cycling network with many possibilities. Or do you prefer a relaxed beach day? The ferry from List will later take you to the island of Rømø. All beaches on Rømø taken together, they form the largest sand beach in Northern Europe.

### Day 8: Havneby – Ribe, approx. 45 km

On today's stage you cycle to the Danish mainland. The oldest town in Denmark is your destination. The disparate towers of Ribe Cathedral can be seen from afar. Visit the 52-meter-high observation deck and let your gaze wander over the entire city.

### Day 9: Ribe – Esbjerg, approx. 35 km + excursion to the island of Fanø

From the mainland you go to the sea again. Your destination today, Esbjerg, has only been around for a good 150 years. The water tower Vandtårnet offers a panoramic view over the island and the city. You can easily reach the island of Fanø by ferry. Discover with a little luck washed up amber there.

### Day 10: Individual departure or extension of stay

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or we extend your stay.
