

# Round trip on Funen

## Your tour

The lush flora and fauna of Funen and the green, varied landscapes earned the island the nickname "Garden of Denmark". You start the round trip in Odense, the main city on the island of Funen. It is considered the bicycle city of Denmark. Other highlights of the tour are the Helnæs peninsula, the "Funen Alps", numerous castles and manor houses as well as exciting evidence of the island's early settlement.

## Child reduction on basic price

0 – 5 years	100 %

#### Bike handover

- → Arrival: The rental bikes are waiting at the start hotel.
- → Departure: The guests leave their bikes in the last hotel. Provided an e-bike has been rented, the battery should be handed in at reception

## Luggage transport

- → Daily baggage collection until 9 a.m.
- → Delivery to the next hotel by 6 p.m. at the latest
- → Luggage items are labeled once for the entire tour
- → No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but a maximum of 20 kg per piece of luggage

## **Stage Description**

## Day 1: Individual arrival to Odense

Odense, the third largest city in Denmark, is the birthplace of the famous poet and writer Hans Christian Andersen. He is commemorated at every turn in the city, which is over 1000 years old. The Sankt Knuds Kirke in the center reflects the prosperity of the city in the Middle Ages and is one of the most important Gothic buildings in Denmark.

## Day 2: Odense - Middelfart, approx. 60 / 65 km

Via cycle route 6 you pedal from Odense to the Little Belt with almost no ascent. The strait between Funen and South Jutland is known for its harbour porpoises. On the way it's worth making a detour to the Strib Fyr lighthouse and the Røjle Klint cliff. In Middelfart, visit Henner Friisers Hus, one of the most beautiful Danish half-timbered houses.

## Day 3: Middelfart - Assens / Ebberup, approx. 40 / 55 km

Along Østersøruten, the Danish Baltic Sea Cycle Route, you follow the coast of the Little Belt. Along the way pristine beaches offer refreshing breaks. The port town of Assens was the hometown of Peter Willemoes. His achievements in the naval battle of Copenhagen in 1801 were honoured with a monument at the harbour. You will spend the night in Assens or Ebberup.

## Day 4: Assens - Fåborg, approx. 45 / 70 km

Today you have the opportunity to circle Helnæs. The peninsula, which is connected to Funen by a dam, offers idyllic nature experiences and impresses with evidence of Stone Age settlements. If you want to skip Helnæs, cycle directly to Fåborg. From Klokketårnet, the bell tower, you have a magnificent view over the city and the sea.

## Day 5: Fåborg – Svendborg, approx. 45 km

Almost close to the coast you cycle to Svendborg, a traditional seafaring town. Visit Anne Hvides Gård, the oldest building in Svendborg. Or how about an evening stroll along the harbour? At Sejlskibsbroen, old wooden boats and sailing ships are anchored and exude a maritime atmosphere.

## Day 6: Svendborg - Nyborg, approx. 45 km

On the way to Nyborg you have the opportunity to stop at one of the numerous beaches. With the sea and the Great Belt Bridge in view, the oldest royal castle in Denmark awaits you in Nyborg. It served as the residence of the Danish kings for many centuries.

## Day 7: Nyborg - Kerteminde - Odense, approx. 50 km

In Kerteminde it is worth visiting the marine research center Fjord & Bælt. It will bring you closer to the marine ecosystem and you can experience porpoises and seals up close. Or how about a longer break at the beach? In Odense, we recommend a boat trip on the Odense  $\mathring{A}$ , which takes you past many sights.

## Day 8: Individual departure or extension of stay

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or we extend your stay.
