Your Tour

Within 15 days you cover about 1000 km on this sporty trip from Flensburg to Usedom. Through the Holstein Switzerland, past the Lübeck Bay and over the peninsula Darß you cycle to Rügen. Despite the many steep coasts there is always the possibility for a cooling dip in the sea. Your journey ends on Usedom, which is known for its imperial seaside resorts.

Bike handover

- Arrival: The rental bikes are waiting at the start hotel.
- Departure: The guests leave their bikes in the last hotel. Provided an e-bike has been rented, the battery should be handed in at reception.

Luggage transport

- Daily baggage collection until 9 a.m.
- Delivery to the next hotel by 6 p.m. at the latest
- Luggage items are labeled once for the entire tour
- No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but a maximum of 20 kg per piece of luggage

Return journey to Flensburg

- On your own by train from Heringsdorf / Mellenthin: connections several times a day, approx. 3 changes. Duration approx. 8 hours

Stage description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Flensburg

Most of German rum imports used to be handled through Flensburg, but it is better known as the seat of a famous mail order catalogue and where the Flensburg Point System is managed – points that can be deducted from driving licenses for reckless driving! You must visit the harbour and see its lovely old warehouses and the museum shipyard.

Day 2: Flensburg – Kappeln, approx. 75 km

Along the Flensburg Fjord you will reach the Renaissance castle in Glücksburg. Continue through tranquil Angeln, the land between Flensburg and the Schlei River, to Kappeln. In Kappeln you should visit the largest Dutch mill in the state, the herring fence and the museum harbour.

Day 3: Kappeln – Kiel, approx. 90 km

Today you first cycle through the landscape of Schwansen, a gentle hilly landscape with steep coasts. Later in the day you pass pretty, little villages and the seaside resort of Damp. You discover lots of prehistoric and Stone Age grave sites. Your destination for the day is Kiel, the capital of Schleswig-Holstein.

Day 4: Kiel – Eutin, approx. 90 km + boat trip

By ferry you cross the Kiel Fjord to Laboe, where the Kiel Canal flows into the Baltic Sea. Laboe is a beautiful little town with a small but fine bathing beach. Your route now takes you further and further away from the coast into the interior of the country. In Eutin you have reached your destination for today's stage.

Day 5: Eutin – Neustadt – Lübeck, approx. 70 km

Via a detour to Neustadt, you first drive along the coast until you finally arrive in Lübeck. The old, magnificent Hanseatic city was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1987. If you talk about the Holsten Gate, marzipan and Thomas Mann, Lübeck immediately comes to mind.

Day 6: Lübeck – Wismar, approx. 80 km + ferry

You continue along the coast, through Brooker Wald nature reserve to Boltenhagen, where you have views of the entire bay from the cliffs. You continue, mostly along the coast, to the old Hanseatic town of Wismar. From here we recommend a short trip to Poel island to explore its long sandy beaches and go for a swim.

Day 7: Wismar – Rostock, approx. 90 km

On the way to Kühlungsborn, cliffs and beautiful beaches alternate along your path, offering great views or great swimming. Just before Nienhagen is the „haunted forest“ - a mixed forest of trees that have taken weird and wonderful shapes because of the age-old influence of the salty, moist sea air and the stormy winds. You cycle to Rostock via Warnemünde.

Day 8: Rostock – Zingst, approx. 80 km + ferry

You cycle to Wustrow, on the Fischland-Darss peninsular, the former border between Mecklenburg and Pommern. Discover Darss woods and the romantic of the wild west beach, which is considered to be one of the most beautiful beaches in the world. Tonight, you stay overnight in Zingst.

Day 9: Zingst – Stralsund, approx. 55 km

Look forward to this section of your tour: the three towers of the Hanseatic town of Stralsund beckon from afar. Its former importance as a trading town can still be seen today. Let your evening come to a pleasant end in the old town, which has been declared a UNESCO World Heritage site, because it has been so beautifully preserved.

Day 10: Stralsund – Ummanz – Breege, approx. 100 km + ferry

Via the island of Rügen you reach the island of Ummanz, which is only 3 meters above sea level. Afterwards you cycle via Vashvitz to the peninsula Wittow, which you reach by ferry (not included). Then it is only a few kilometers to Breege, your destination for today.

Day 11: Breege – Kap Arkona – Sassnitz, approx. 80 km

Via the Cape Arkona, with its steep coast of up to 43 meter high cliffs, you cycle to Sassnitz on the island of Rügen. Don't forget to visit the famous chalk cliff north of the town.

Day 12: Sassnitz – Göhren, approx. 40 km

You will pass many well-known Baltic Sea resorts along your route today. In Binz, the largest seaside resort on Rügen awaits you, and in Sellin you can walk almost 400 meters out to sea on Rügen's longest pier. Your destination today, Göhren, awaits you with long and fine sandy beaches.

Day 13: Göhren – Greifswald, approx. 75 km + ferry

Today you say goodbye to Rügen and board the car ferry in Glewitz (not included), which will take you back to the mainland. You cycle the last kilometers to the old Hanseatic city of Greifswald.

Day 14: Greifswald – Heringsdorf / Mellenthin, approx. 90 km

Today you cycle along the Baltic Coast Cycle Route to Wolgast, whose historic city center is partly on an island. Over the Peene Bridge you will reach the sunny island of Usedom and cycle along the Krumminer Wiek to Krummin and from there to the Baltic Sea resort of Zinnowitz. With the magnificent imperial seaside resorts in Heringsdorf you have reached your destination. Alternatively, you spend the night in Mellenthin.

Day 15: Individual departure or extended stay

After breakfast, you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
