Bike handover

- → Arrival: The rental bikes are waiting at the start hotel.
- → Departure: The guests leave their bikes in the last hotel. Provided an e-bike has been rented, the battery should be handed in at reception.

Luggage transport

- → Daily baggage collection until 9 a.m.
- \rightarrow Delivery to the next hotel by 6 p.m. at the latest
- → Luggage items are labeled once for the entire tour
- → No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but a maximum of 20 kg per piece of luggage

Return journey to Hamburg

→ On your own by train from Niebüll, connections several times a day, direct connection, duration approx. 2.5 hours.

Stage description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Hamburg

The metropolis on the Elbe captivates with its maritime charm and is ideally suited as a starting point for a cycling tour. We recommend an early arrival, as the city really has a lot to offer.

Day 2: Hamburg - Glückstadt, approx. 55 km

Beyond the city limits of Hamburg, a first stopover in Wedel is worthwhile. Here you can watch the Willkomm-Höft ship welcoming facility as it greets or bids farewell to incoming and departing ships by flying the Hamburg flag. Your destination for the day is Glückstadt, which was founded in 1617.

Day 3: Glückstadt - St. Michaelisdonn / Burg, approx. 55 km

Along the Elbe you reach Brunsbüttel, where the Kiel Canal begins. The cycle path takes you through the lush green Dithmarschen to St. Michaelisdonn. The Edda Dutchman's Mill is the landmark of this community.

Day 4: St. Michaelisdonn / Burg - Tönning, approx. 65 km

Along the Elbe you reach Brunsbüttel, where the Kiel Canal begins. The cycle path takes you through the lush green Dithmarschen to St. Michaelisdonn. The Edda Dutchman's Mill is the landmark of this community.

Day 5: Tönning - Husum, approx. 60 km

Your day begins with a train ride to St. Peter-Ording. More than 100 years ago, pile dwellings were built on this famous 12 km long sandy beach to cater for the physical well-being of beach visitors. Today's destination is Husum, the home town of the famous writer Theodor Storm.

Day 6: Husum - Niebüll, approx. 55 km

Always along the coast, a first detour to the Hamburger Hallig is worthwhile. The peninsula is only one square kilometre in size. Continue to Niebüll via Schlüttsiel harbour and through Dagebüll. This is where Frisian and Danish culture meet.

Day 7: Excursion to the Island of Sylt

First, you travel by train to the island of Sylt. The island consists of a network of over 200 kilometres of cycle paths. You decide on your last cycling day, which route you would like to take to explore the island. The train brings you back to Niebüll in the evening.

Day 8: Individual departure or extension of stay

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or we extend your stay.
